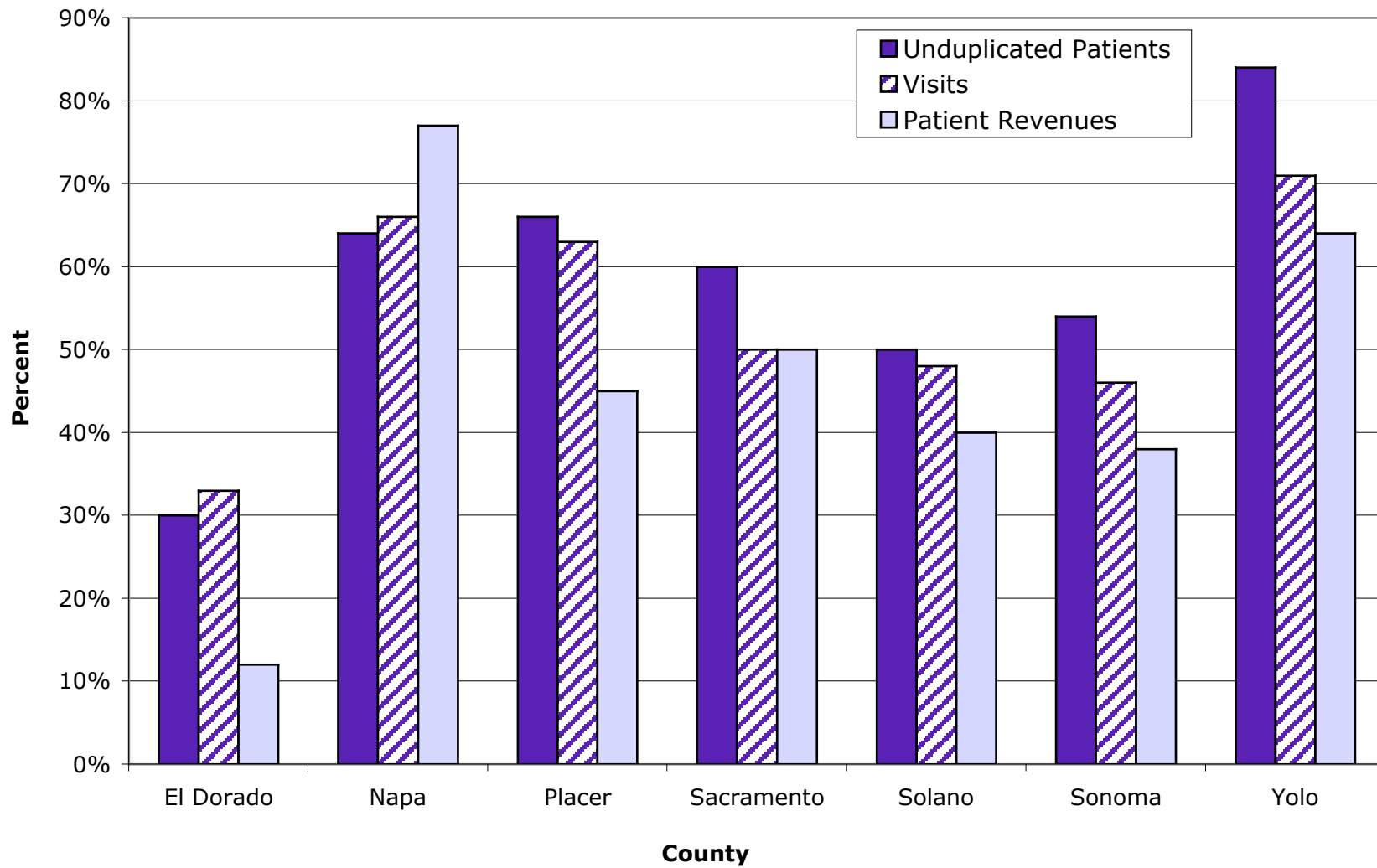

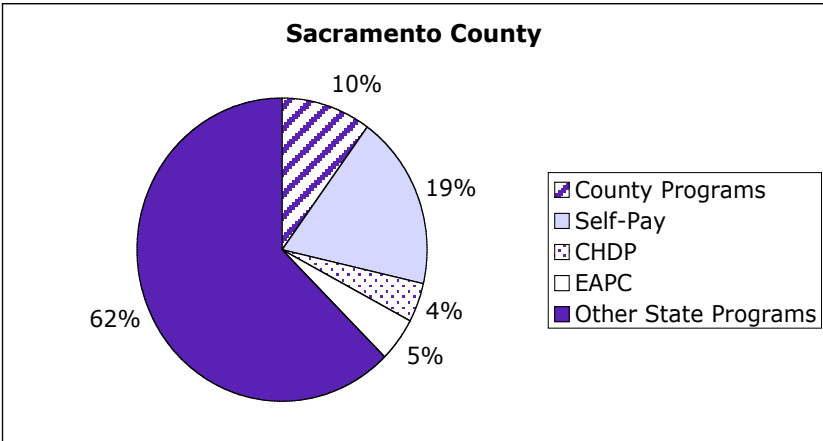
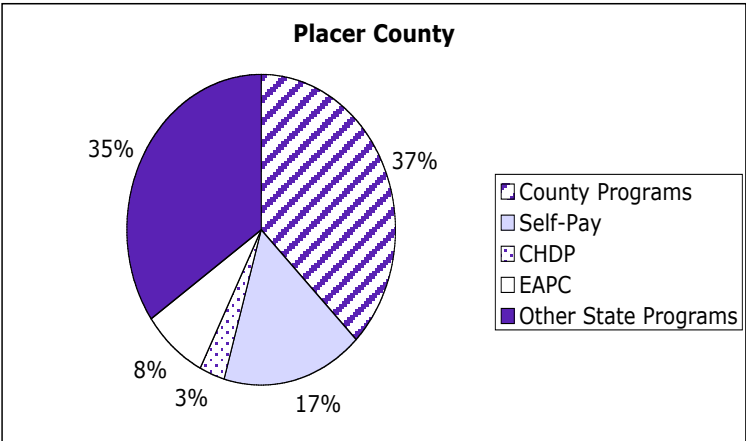
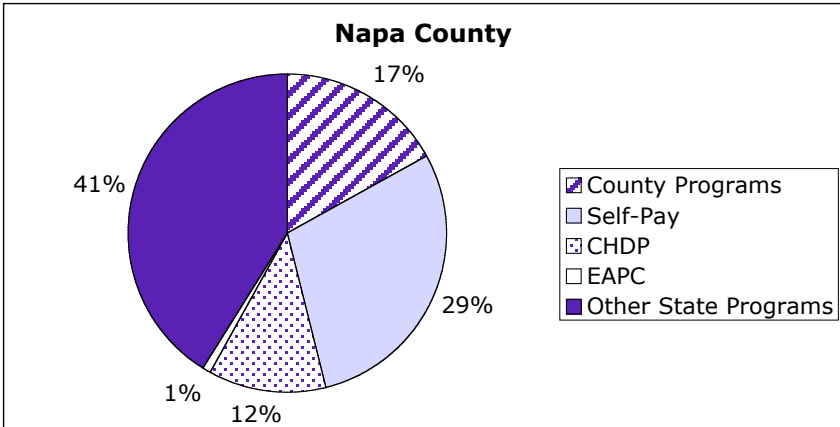
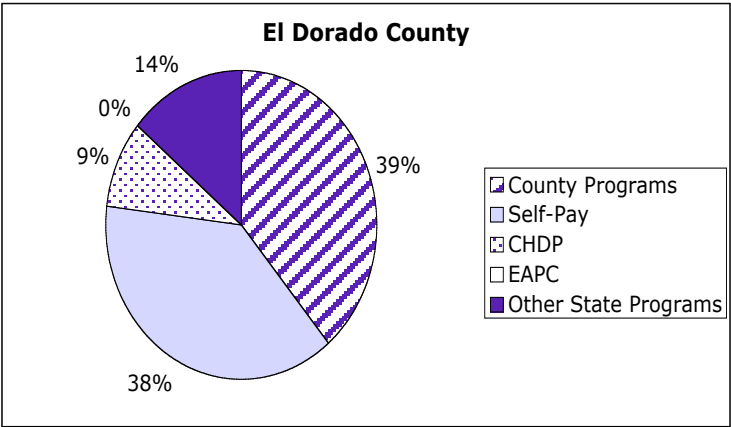
Unduplicated Patients, Visits and Patient Revenues by Payer for Community Clinics in Seven Northern Central California Counties, 2000 (OSHPD)



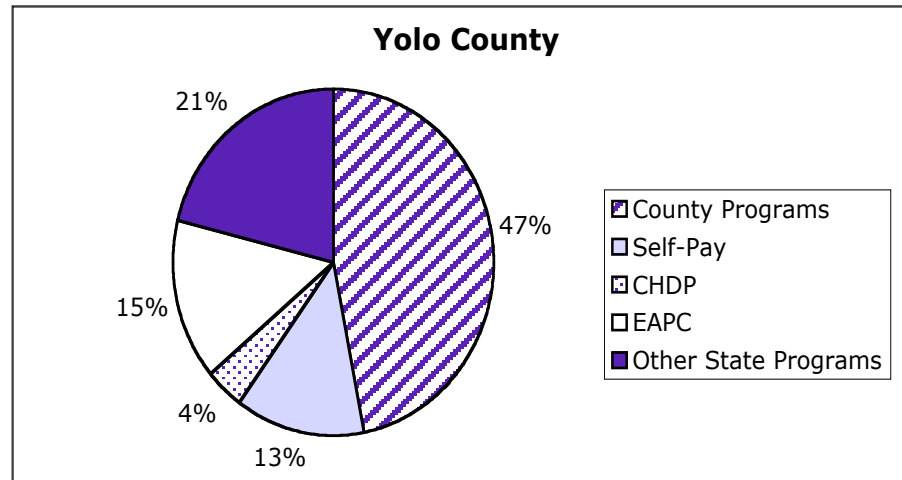
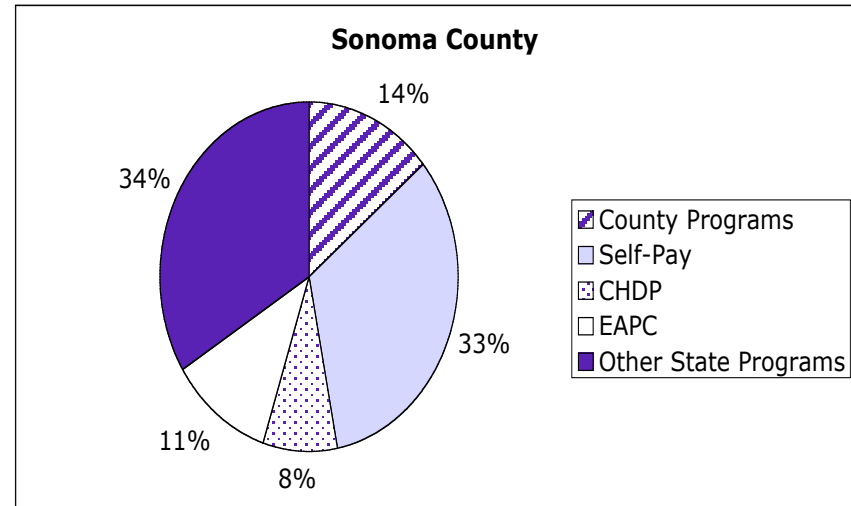
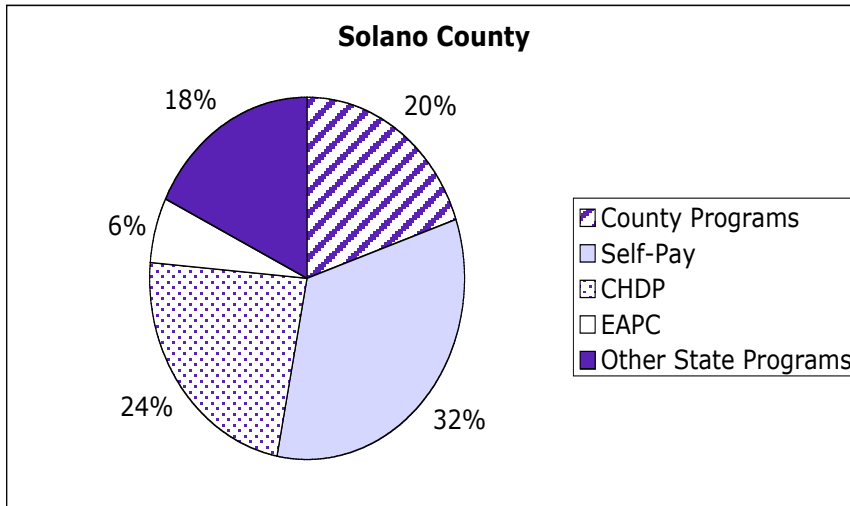
Uninsured Unduplicated Community Clinic Patients, Visits and Patient Revenues by County, 2000 (OSHPD)



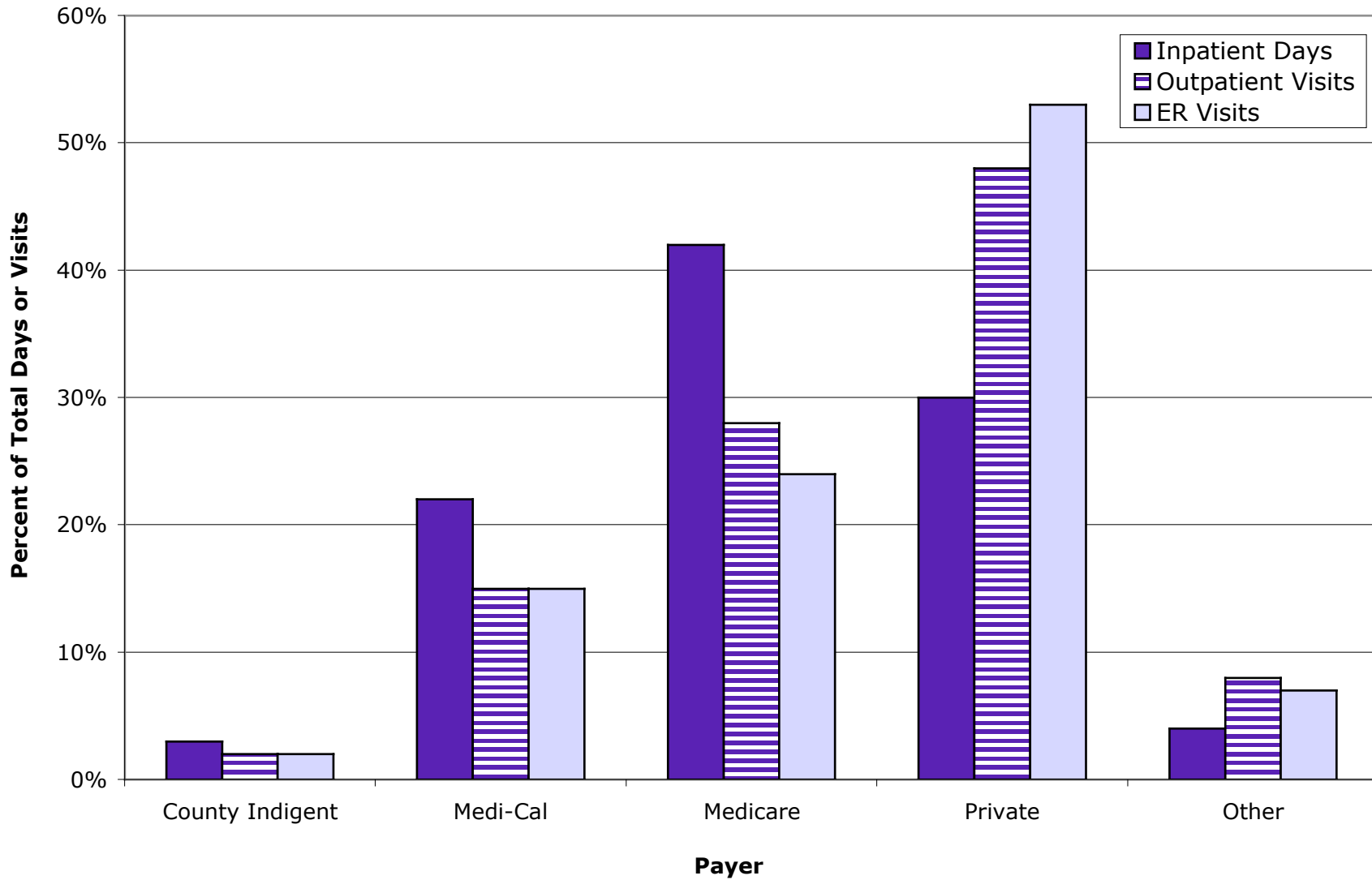
Northern Central California Study Counties' Community Clinic Uninsured Revenues, 2000 (OSHPD)



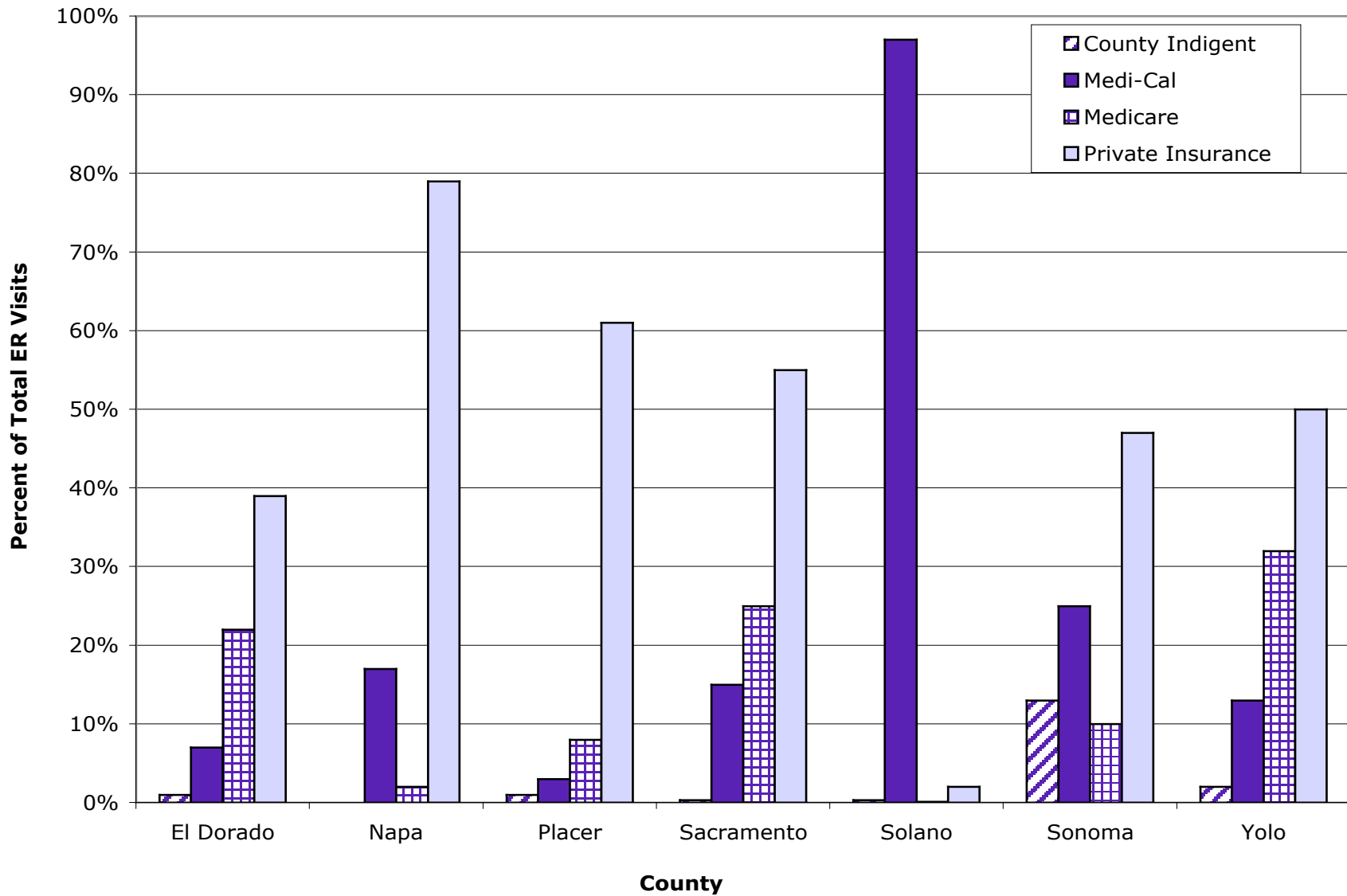

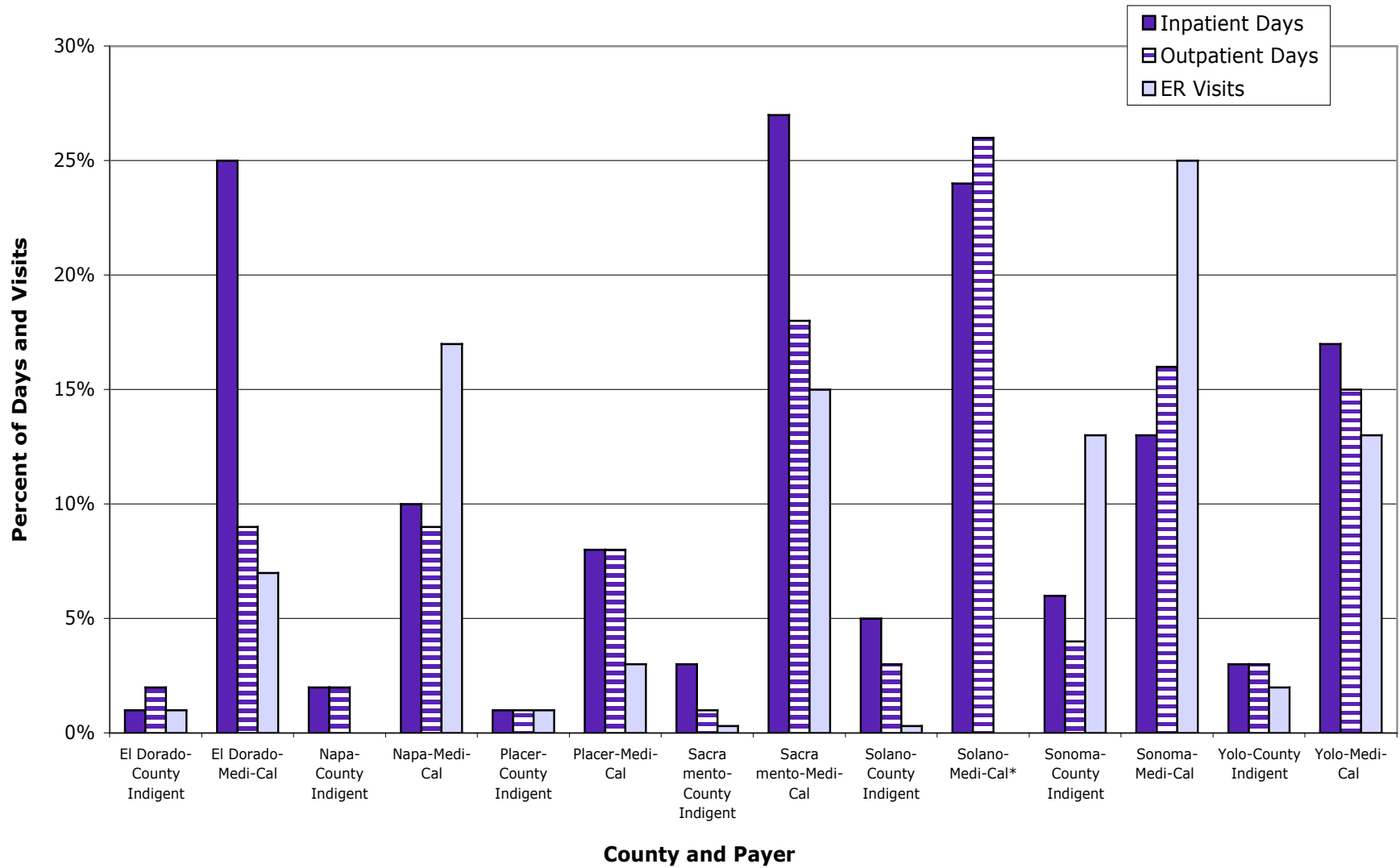
Hospital Utilization by Payer for the Northern Central California Study Counties, 2001 (OSHPD)



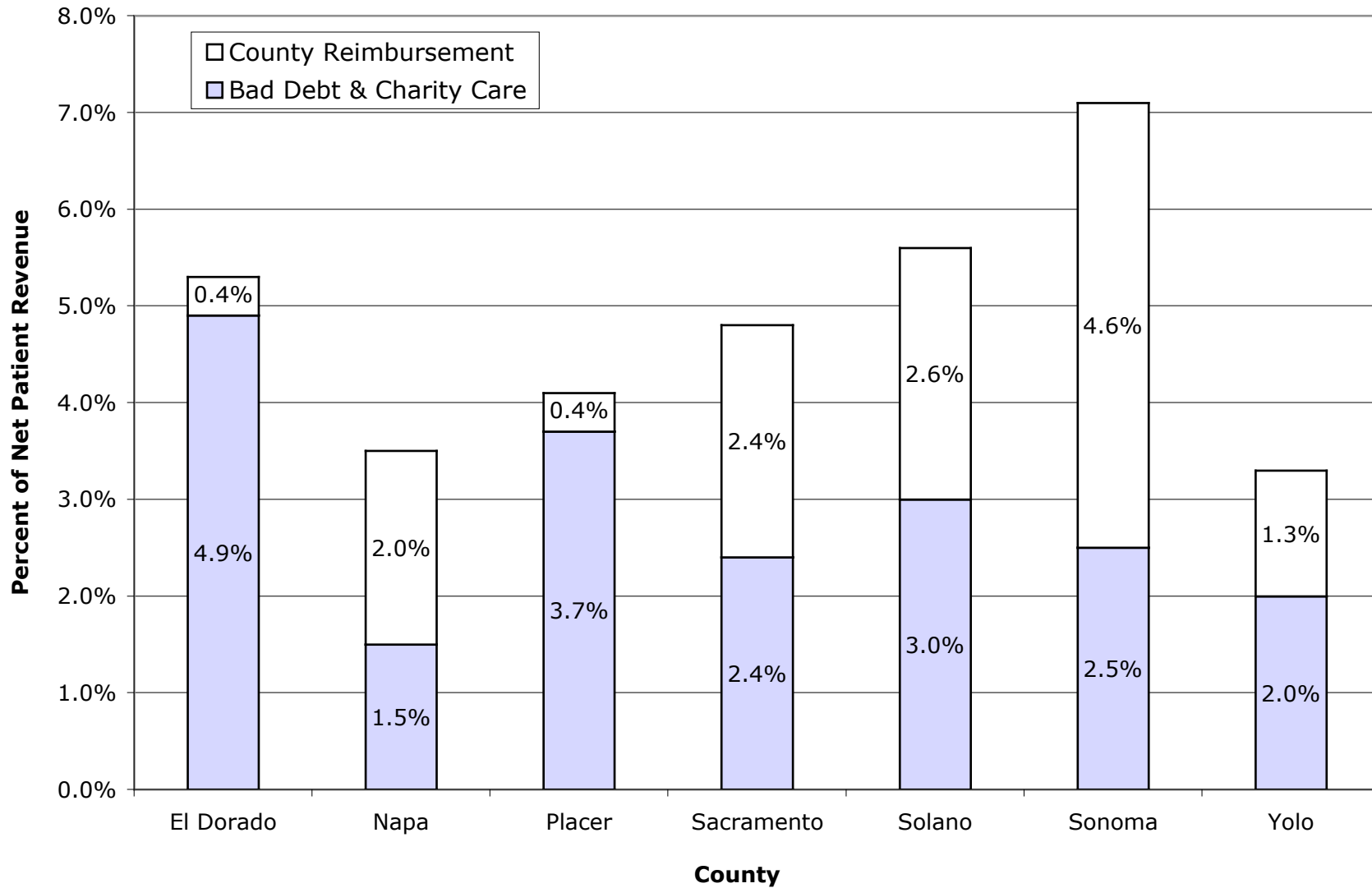
Emergency Room Utilization by Payer and County in the Northern Central California Study Counties, 2001 (OSHPD)



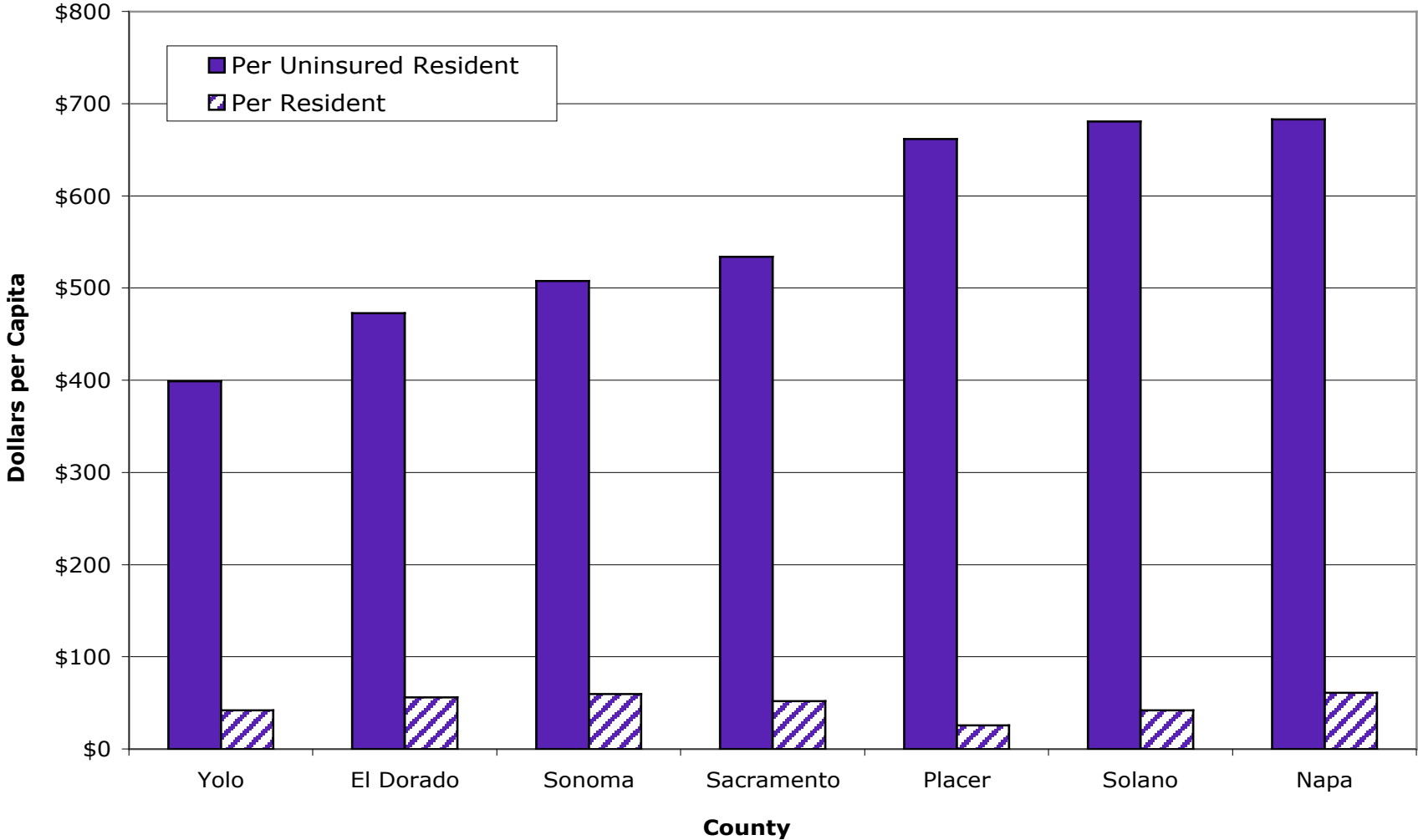
County Indigent and Medi-Cal Patients' Hospital Utilization in Northern Central California, 2001 (OSHPD)
