

WHO IS UNINSURED IN THE CENTRAL NORTH?¹
El Dorado, Napa, Placer, Sacramento, Solano, Sonoma and Yolo Counties
Prepared by Insure the Uninsured Project (ITUP)
June 2003

Approximately 9 percent of the Central North's non-elderly population does not have health care coverage. Of the region's 225,000 uninsured residents, approximately 193,000 are adults under the age of 65 and 32,000 are children under 18. The majority of the region's uninsured are employed but not offered job-based insurance, earn low wages and work for small employers. Compared to Central North residents with health insurance, the uninsured are less likely to report consistent access to care and more likely to report poor or fair health.
