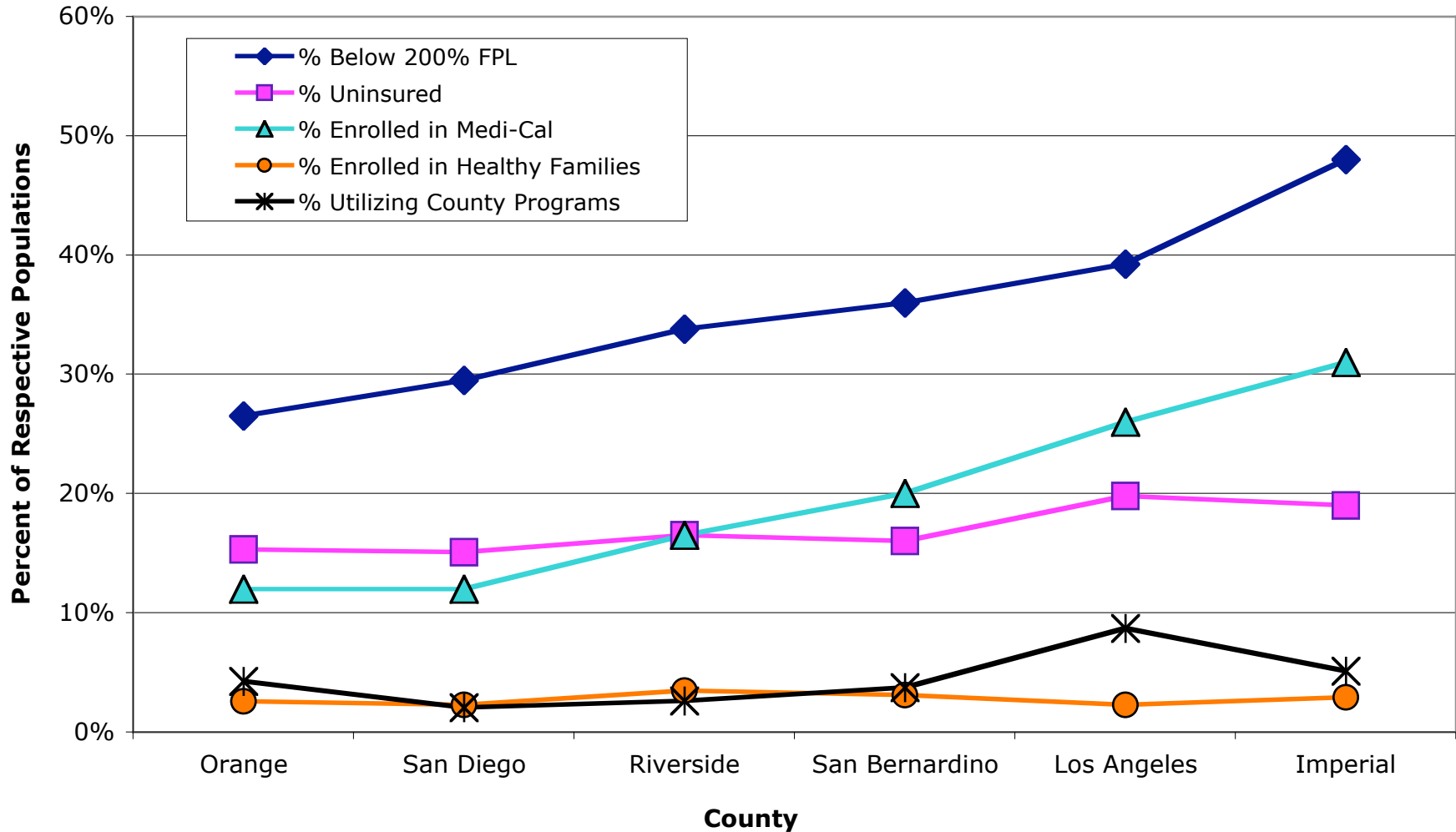


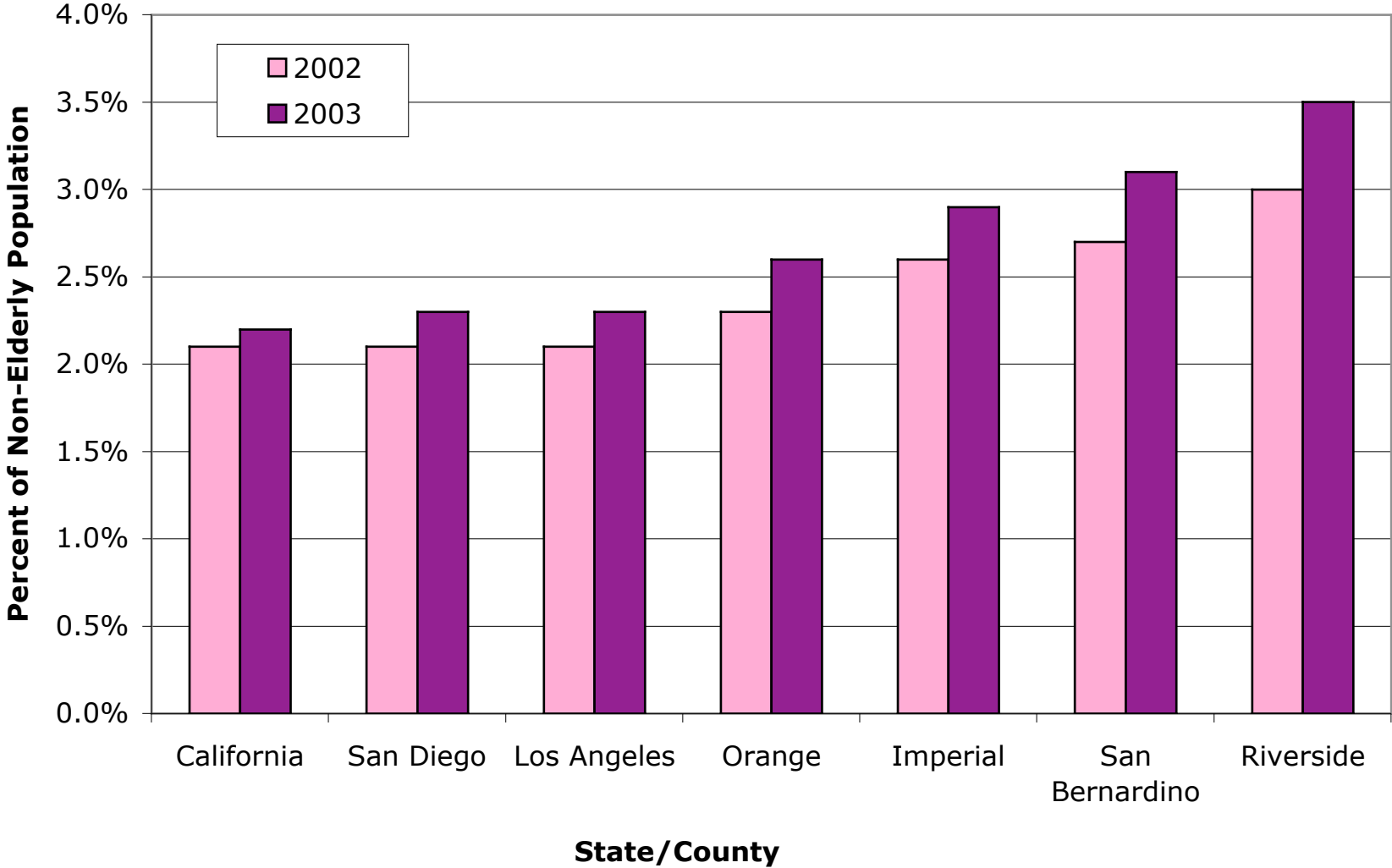

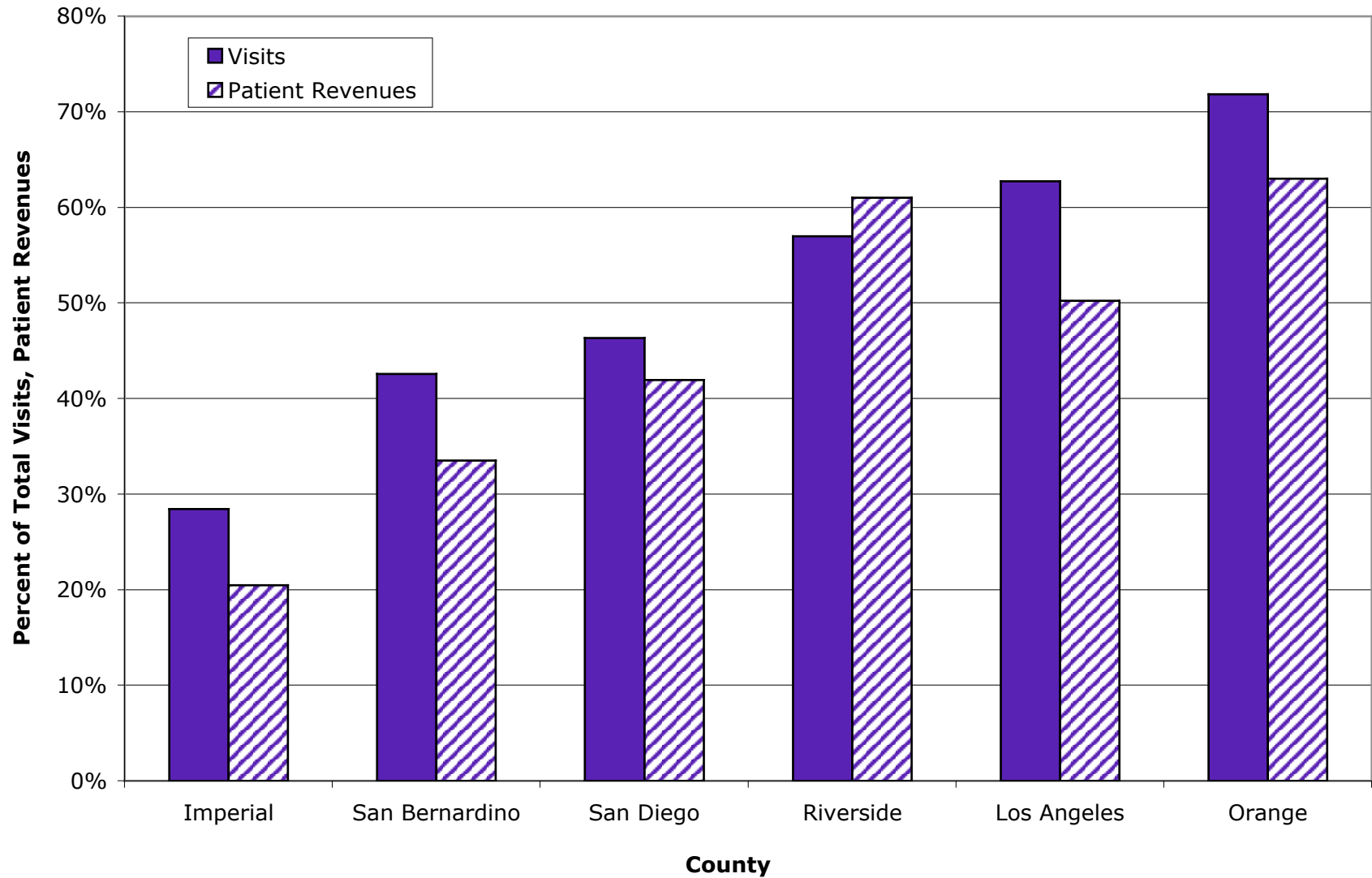

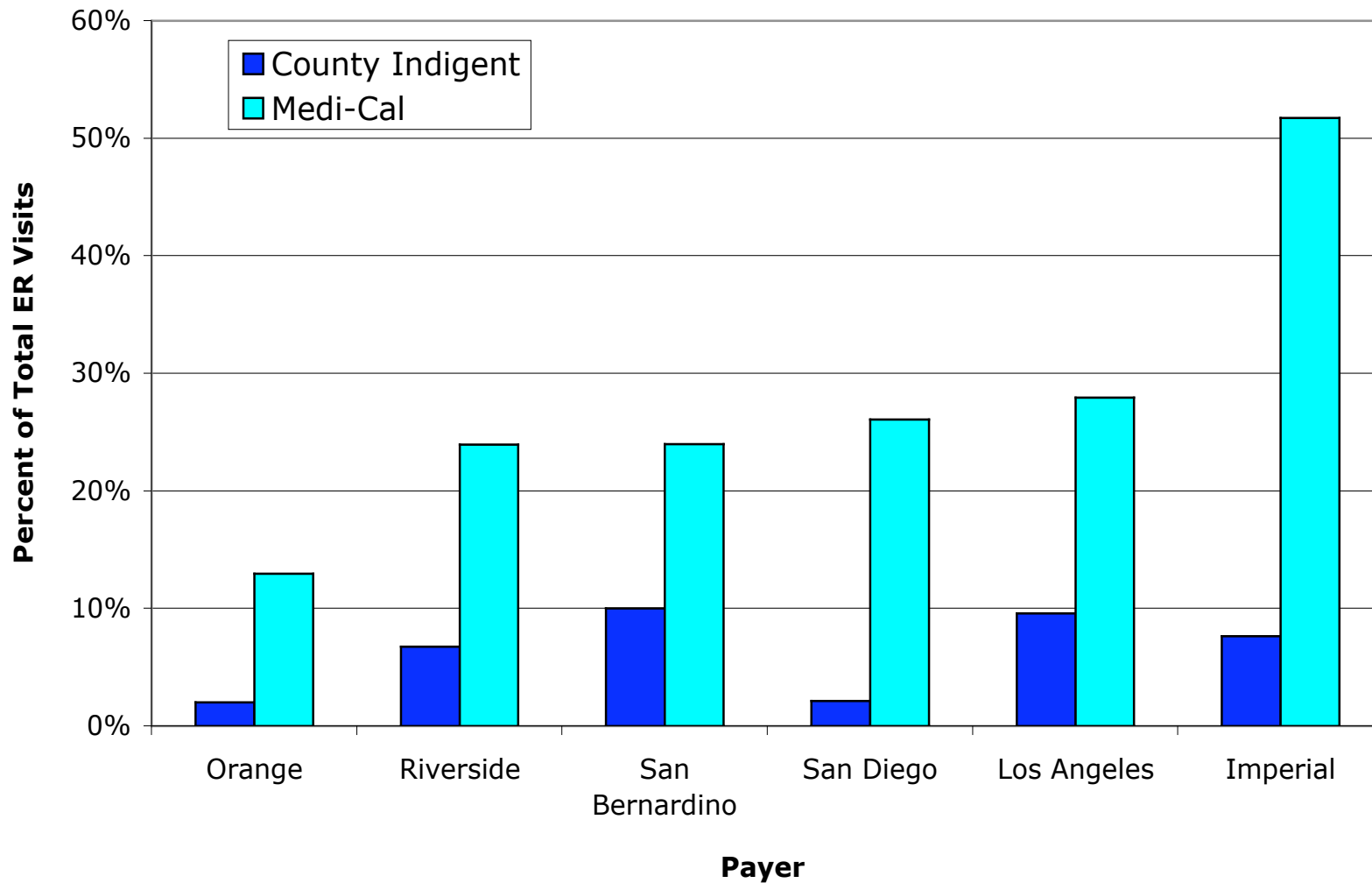
# Healthy Families Enrollment in Southern California, 2002-2003 (MRMIB)



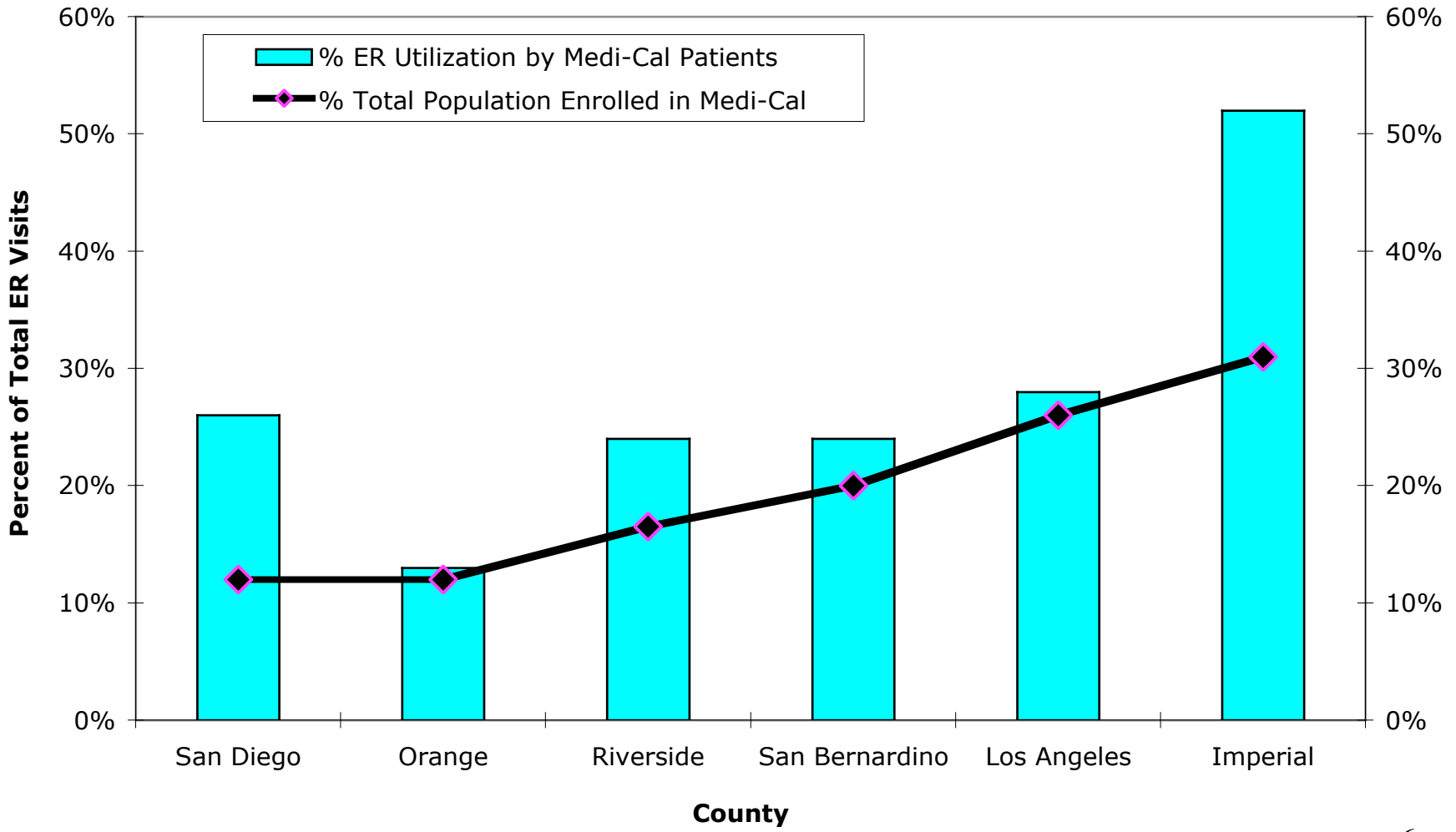
### Uninsured Visits and Patient Revenues by County in Six Southern California Study Counties, 2002 (OSHPD)



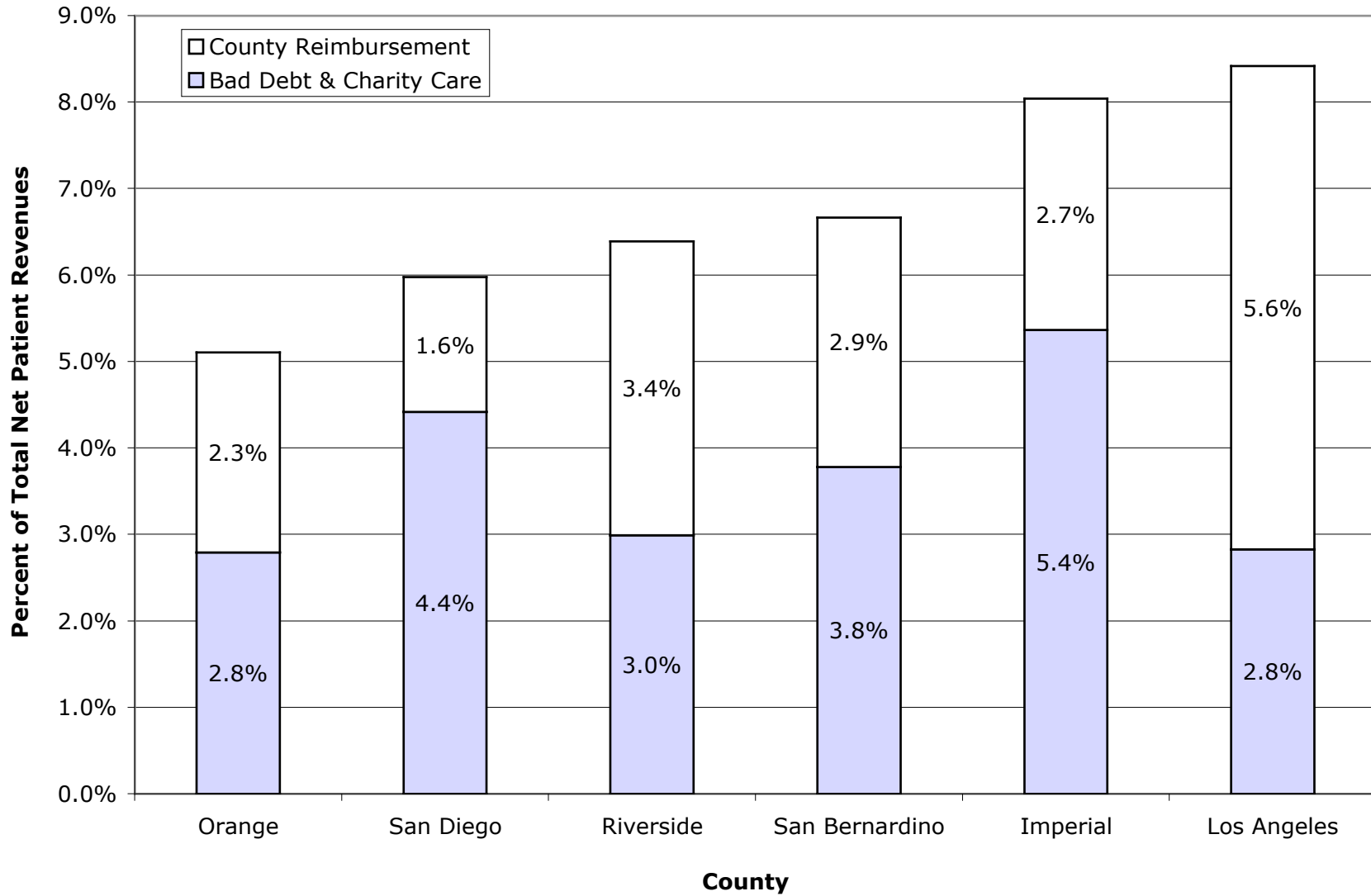
## County Indigent and Medi-Cal Patients' Emergency Room Utilization in Southern California, 2002 (OSHPD)



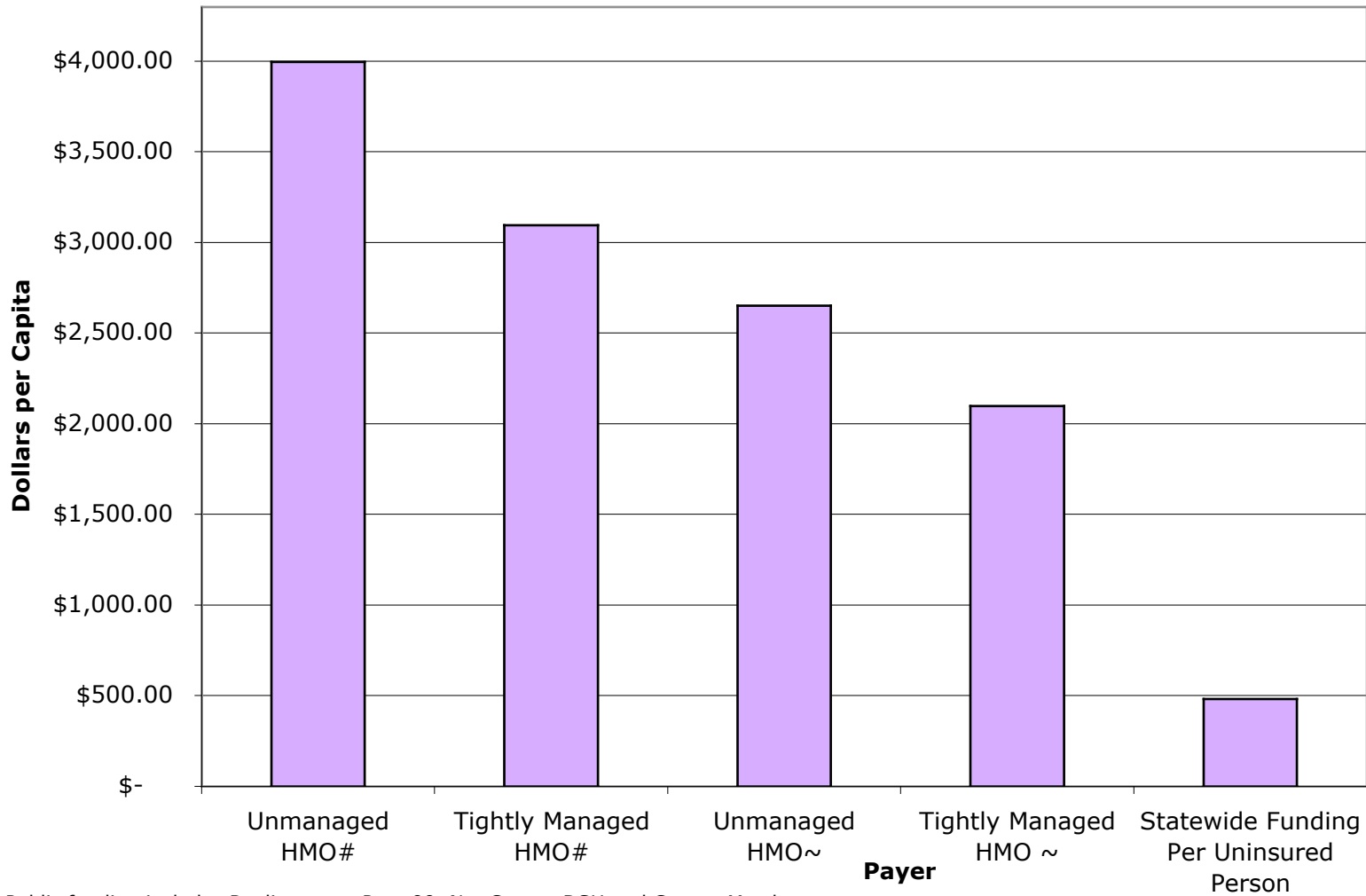

## Hospital Spending for the Uninsured as Percentage of Net Patient Revenue by County, 2002 (OSHPD)

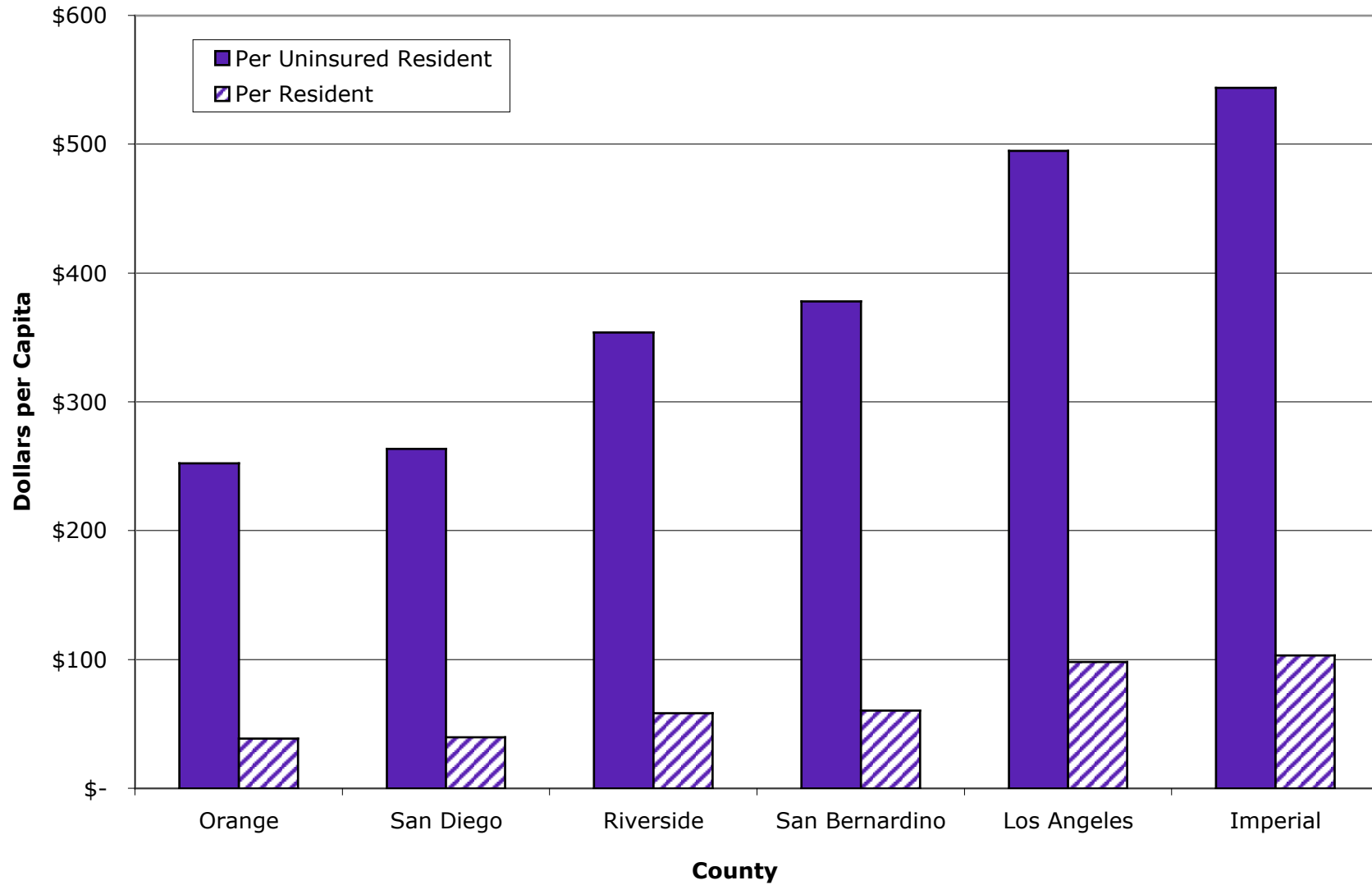
