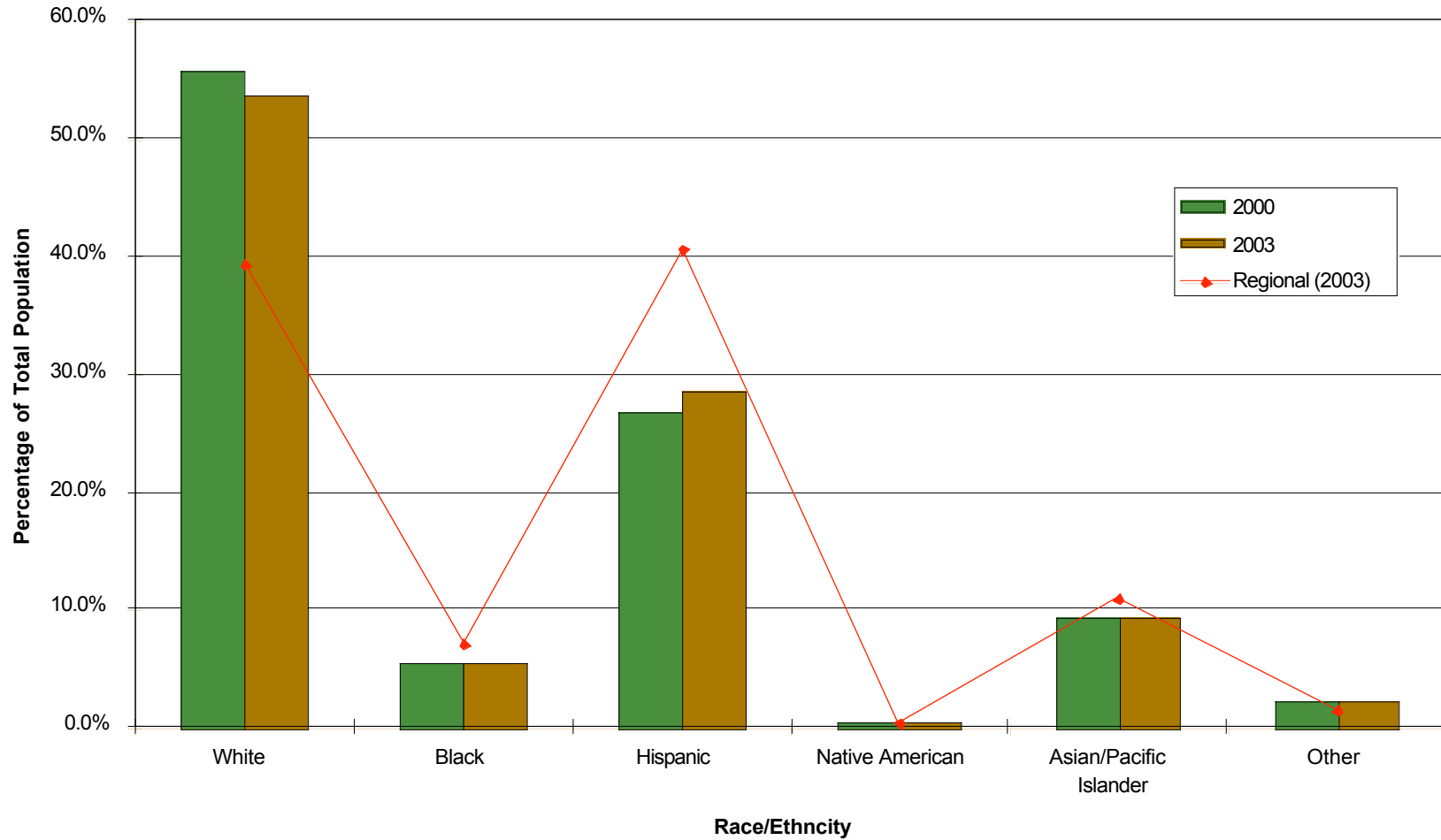

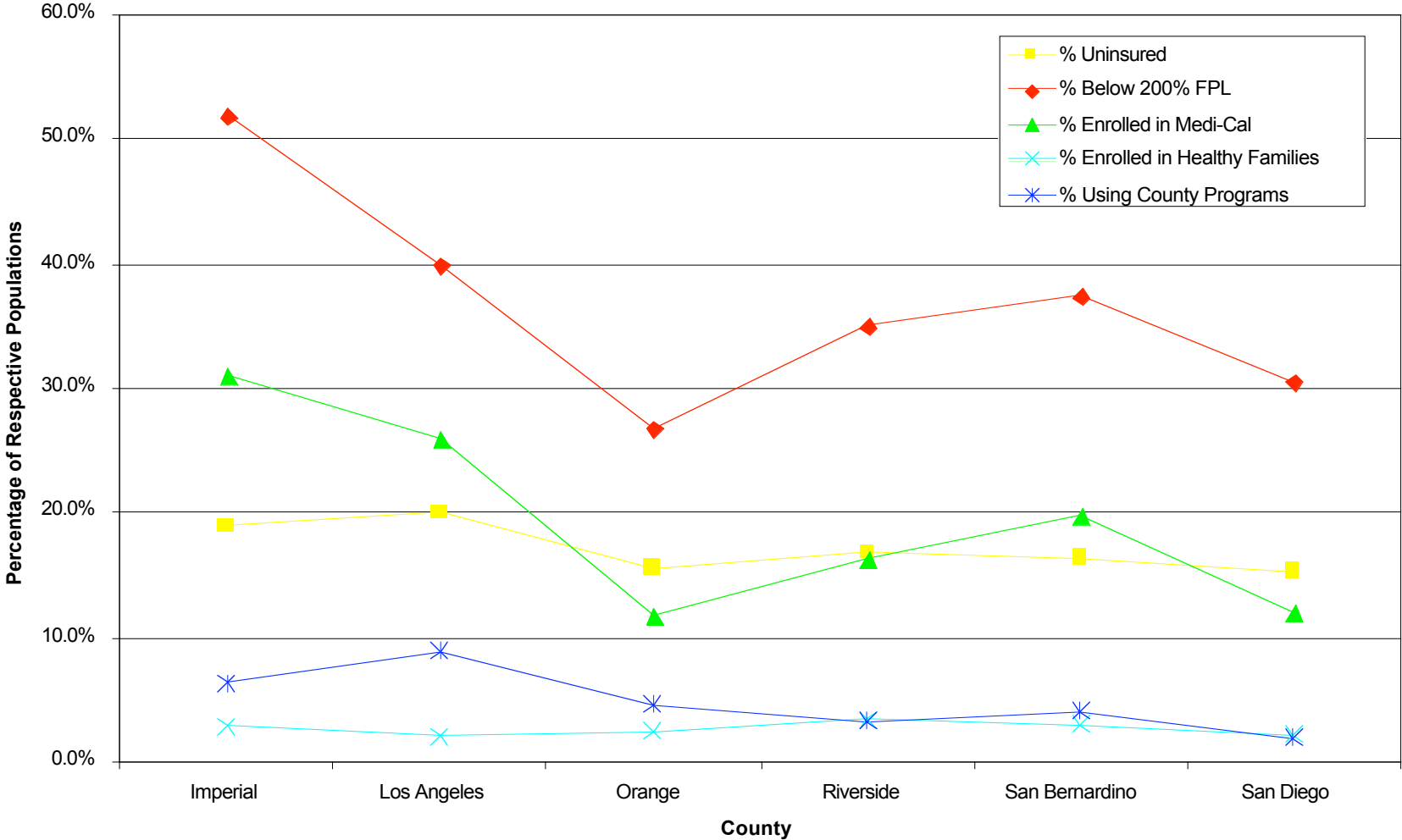

## San Diego County Ethnicity, 2000 vs. 2003



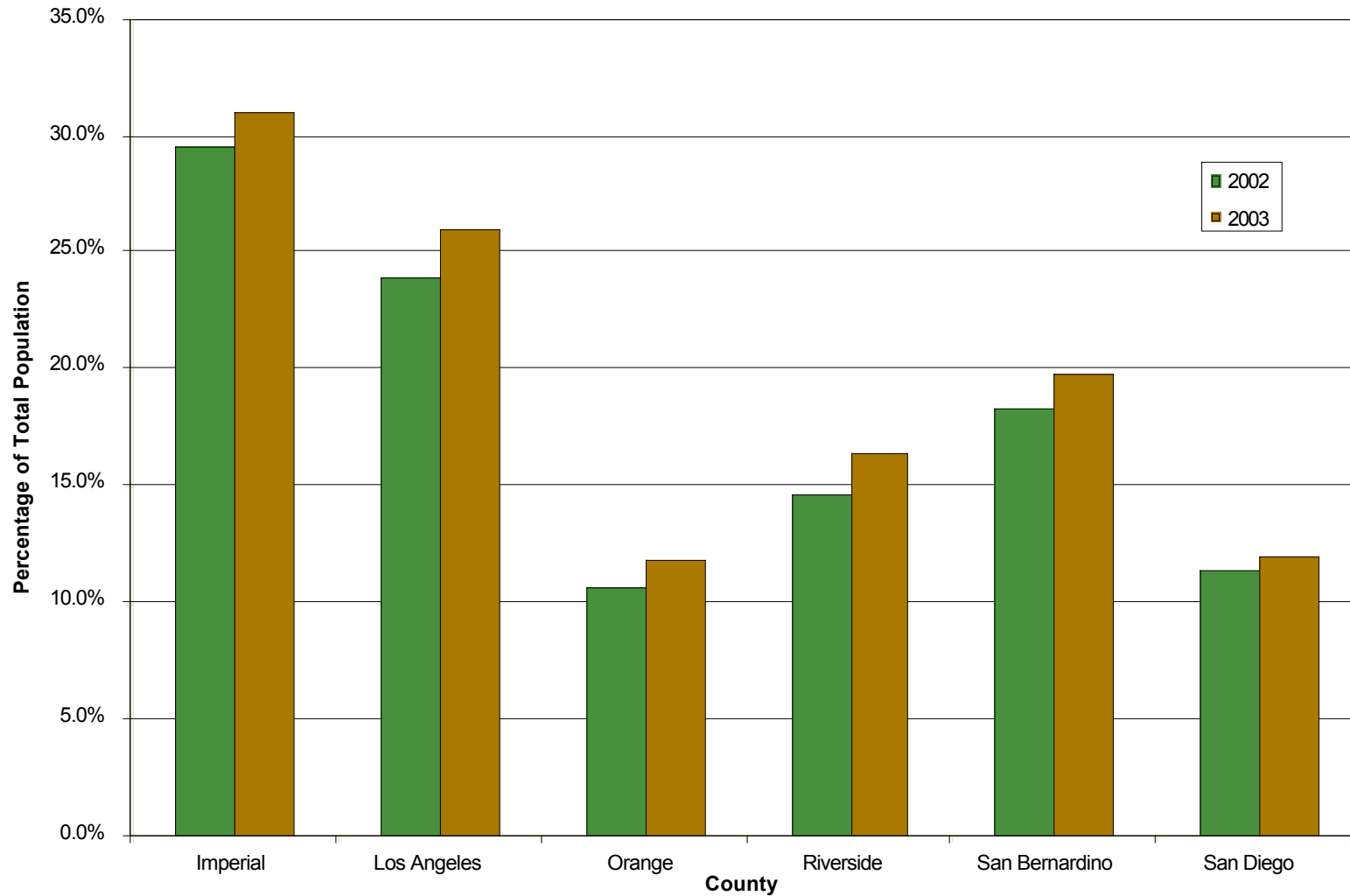

# Rates of Poverty and Insurance Status



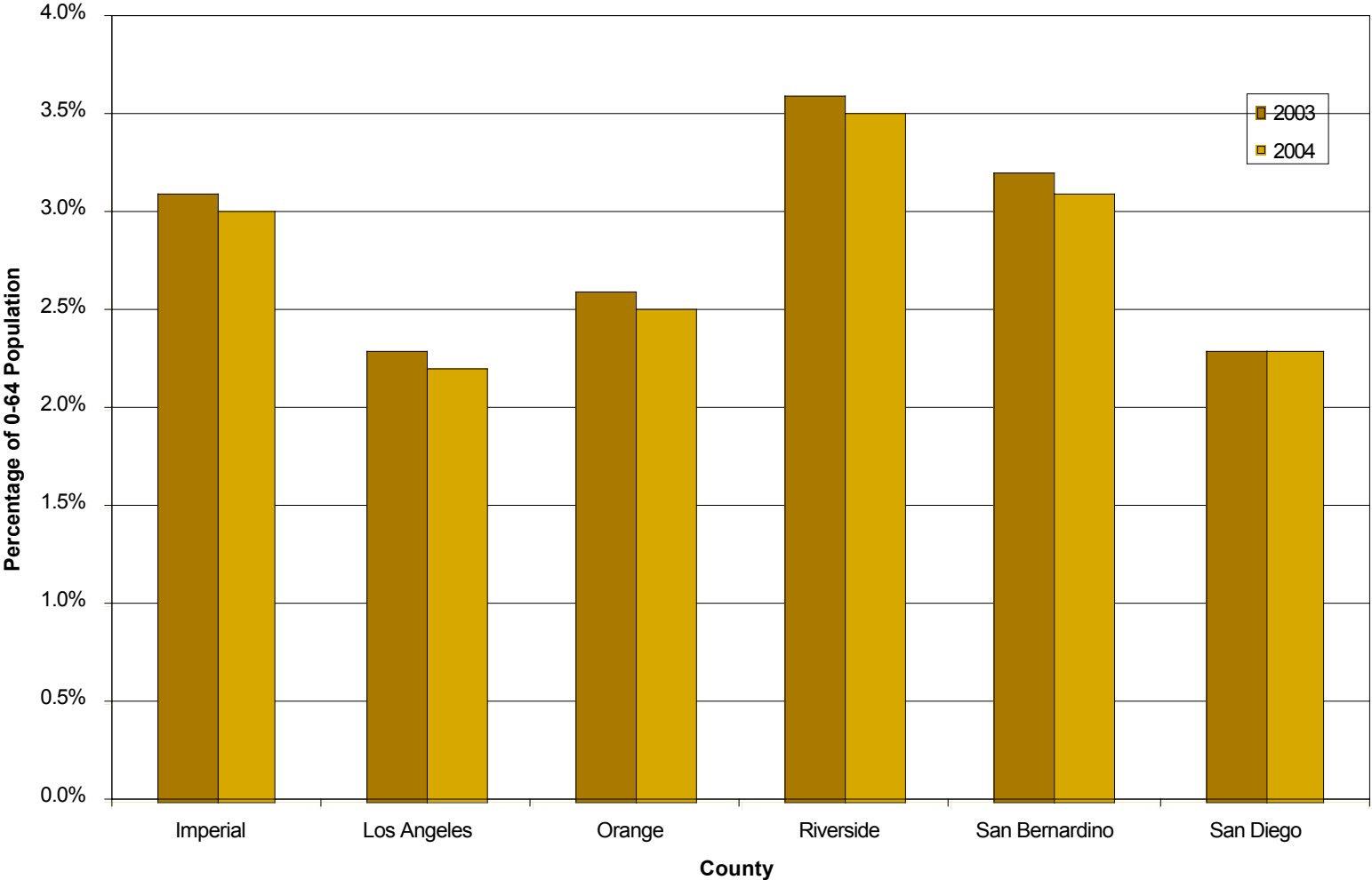

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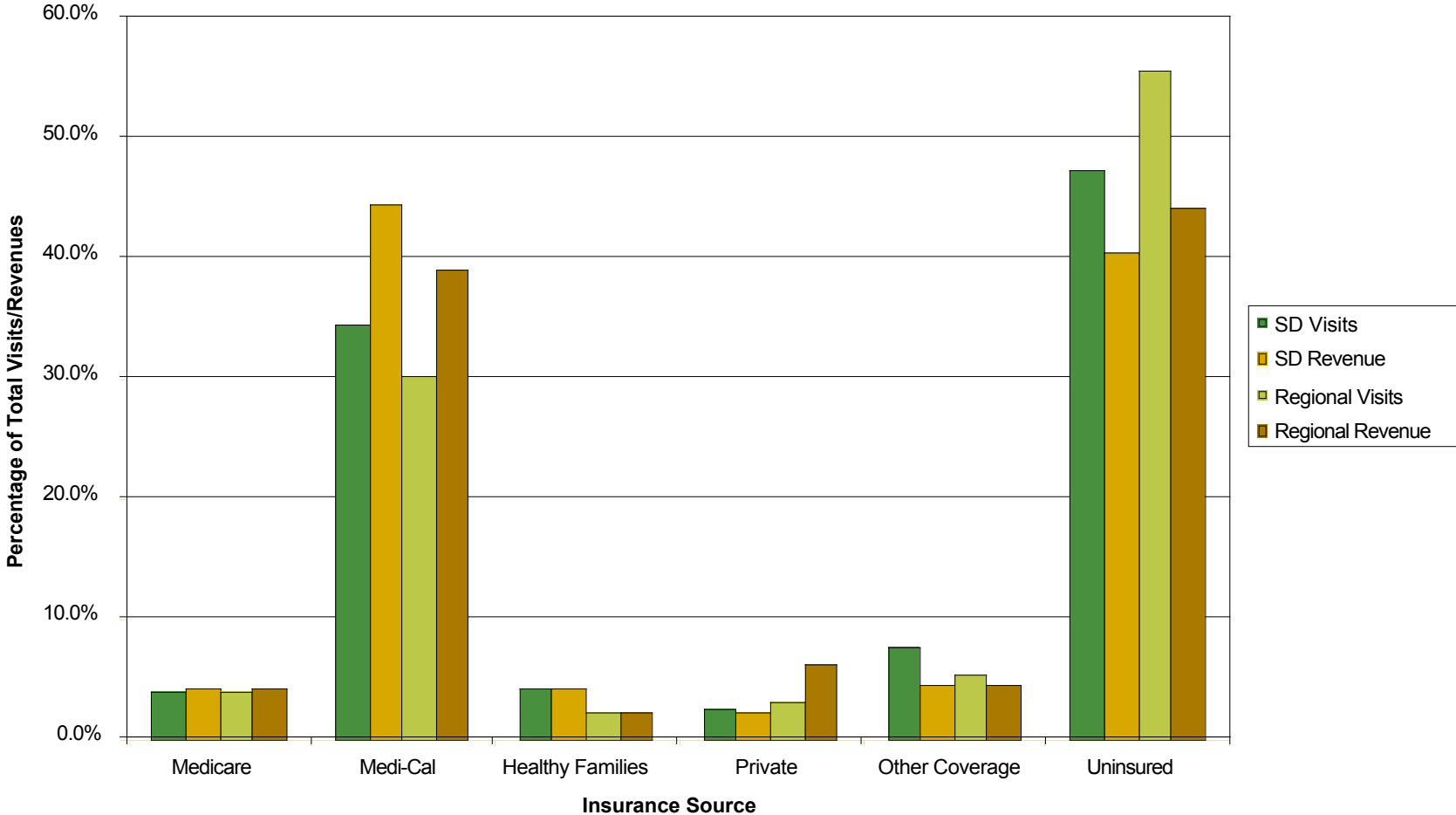

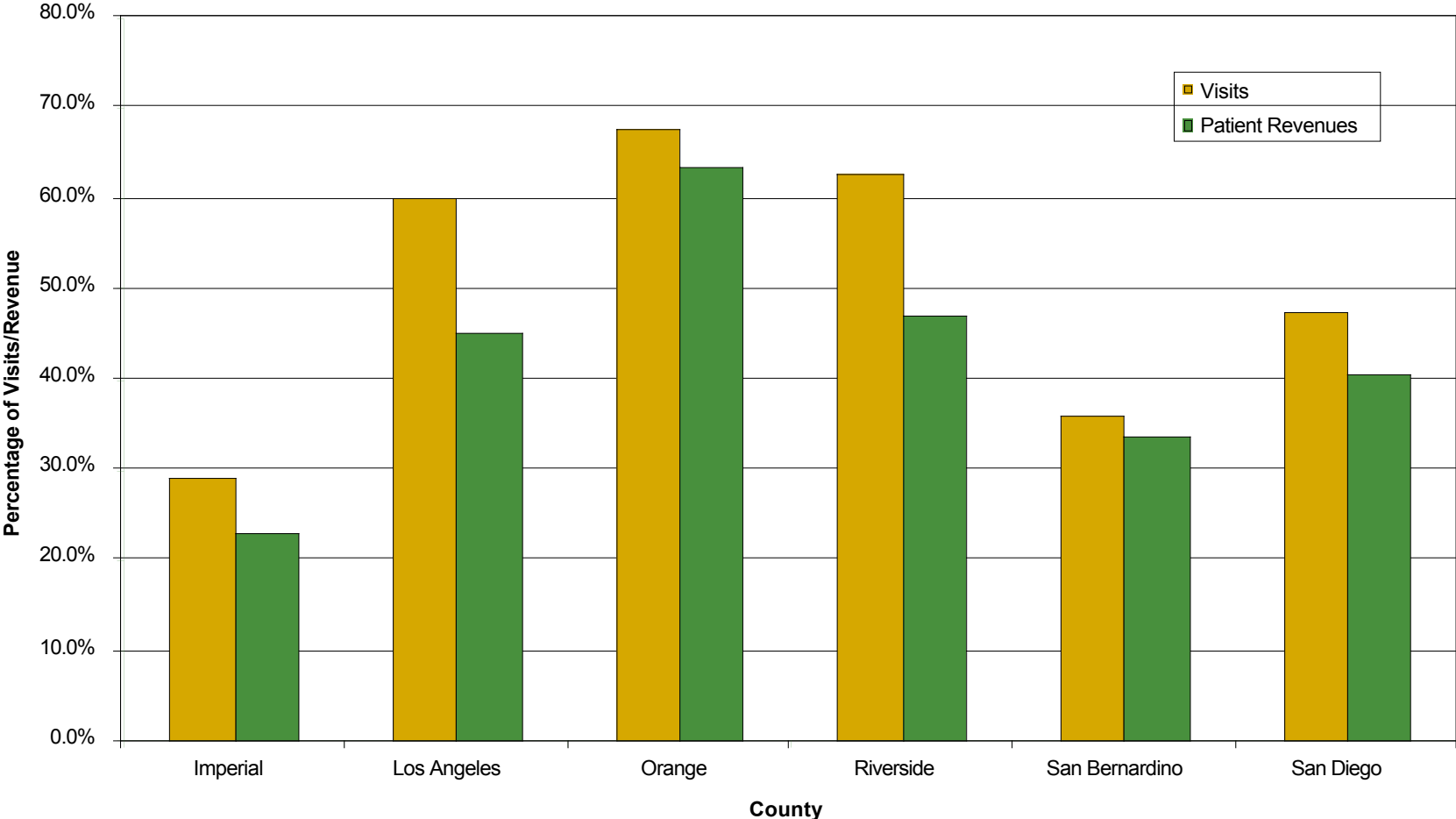

# San Diego County Community Clinic Visits & Revenue by Insurance Source



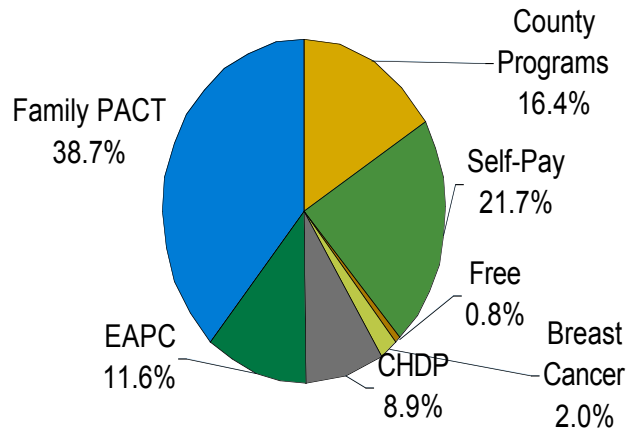

# Southern California Uninsured Clinic Visits & Revenue

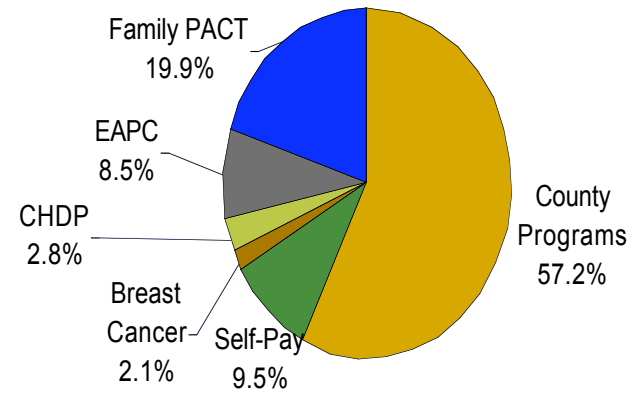

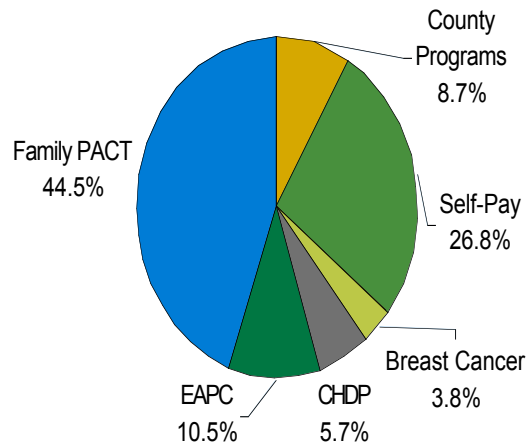
**Imperial County Uninsured Patient Clinic Revenue**



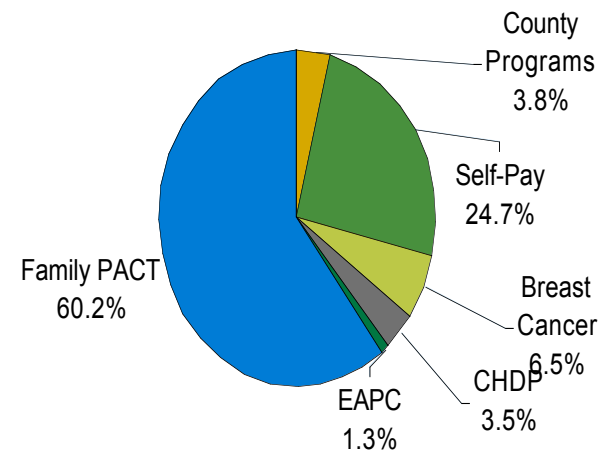
**Los Angeles County Uninsured Patient Clinic Revenue**



**Orange County Uninsured Patient Clinic Revenue**

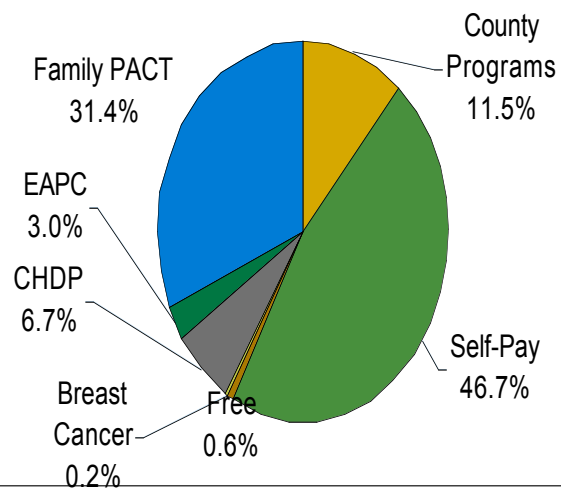


**Riverside County Uninsured Patient Clinic Revenue**

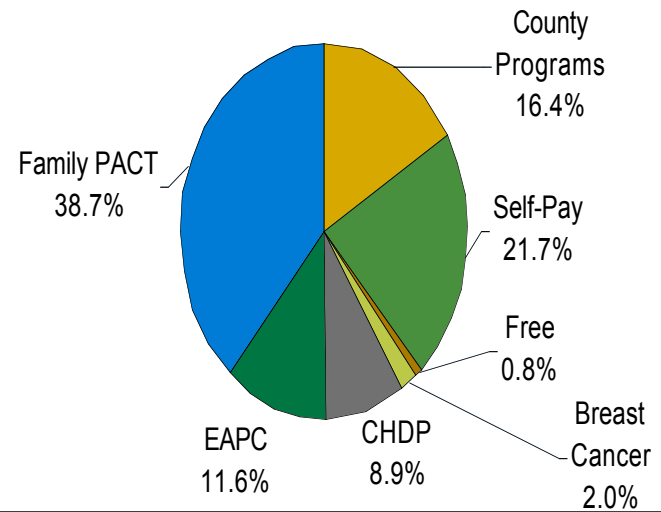

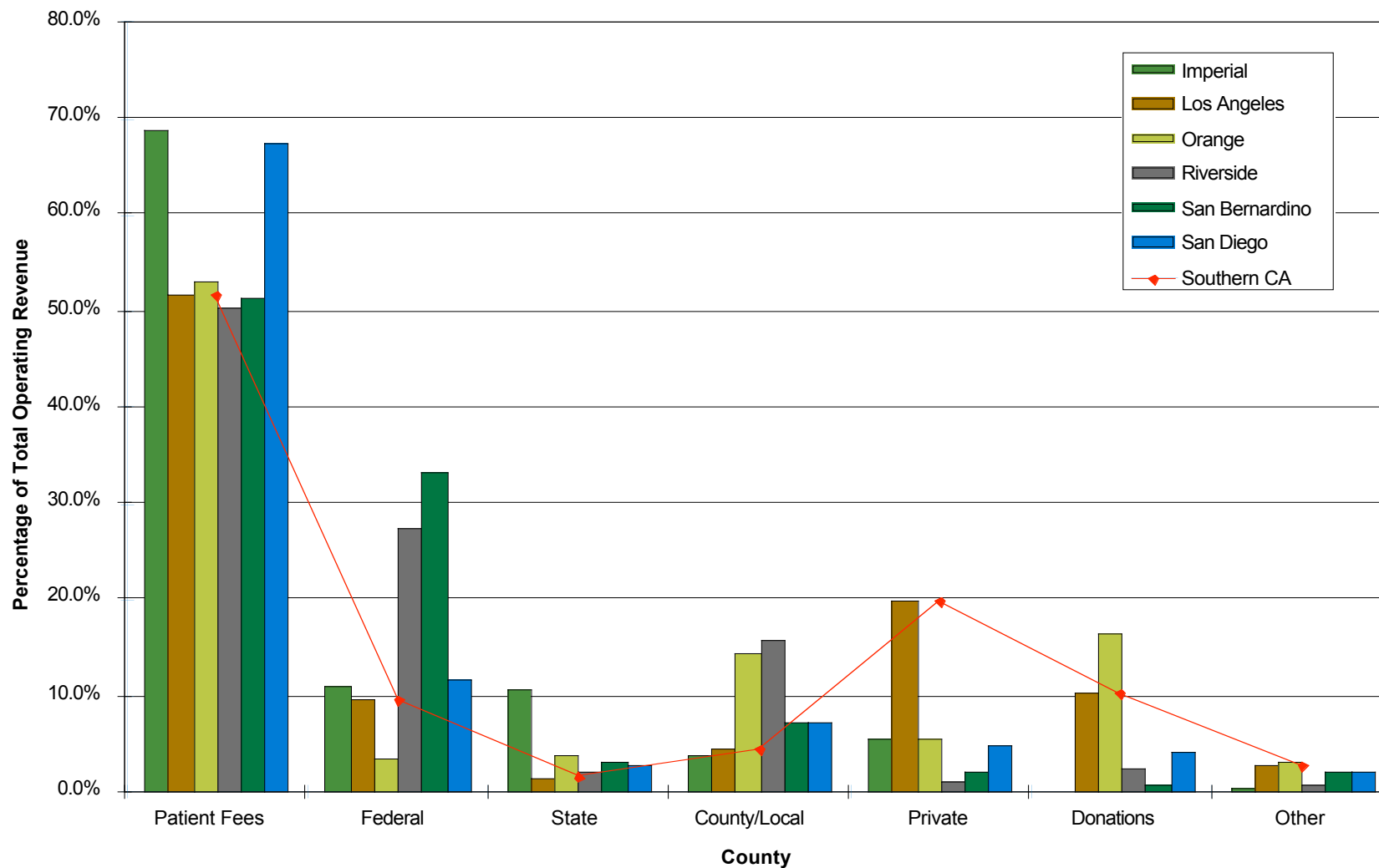

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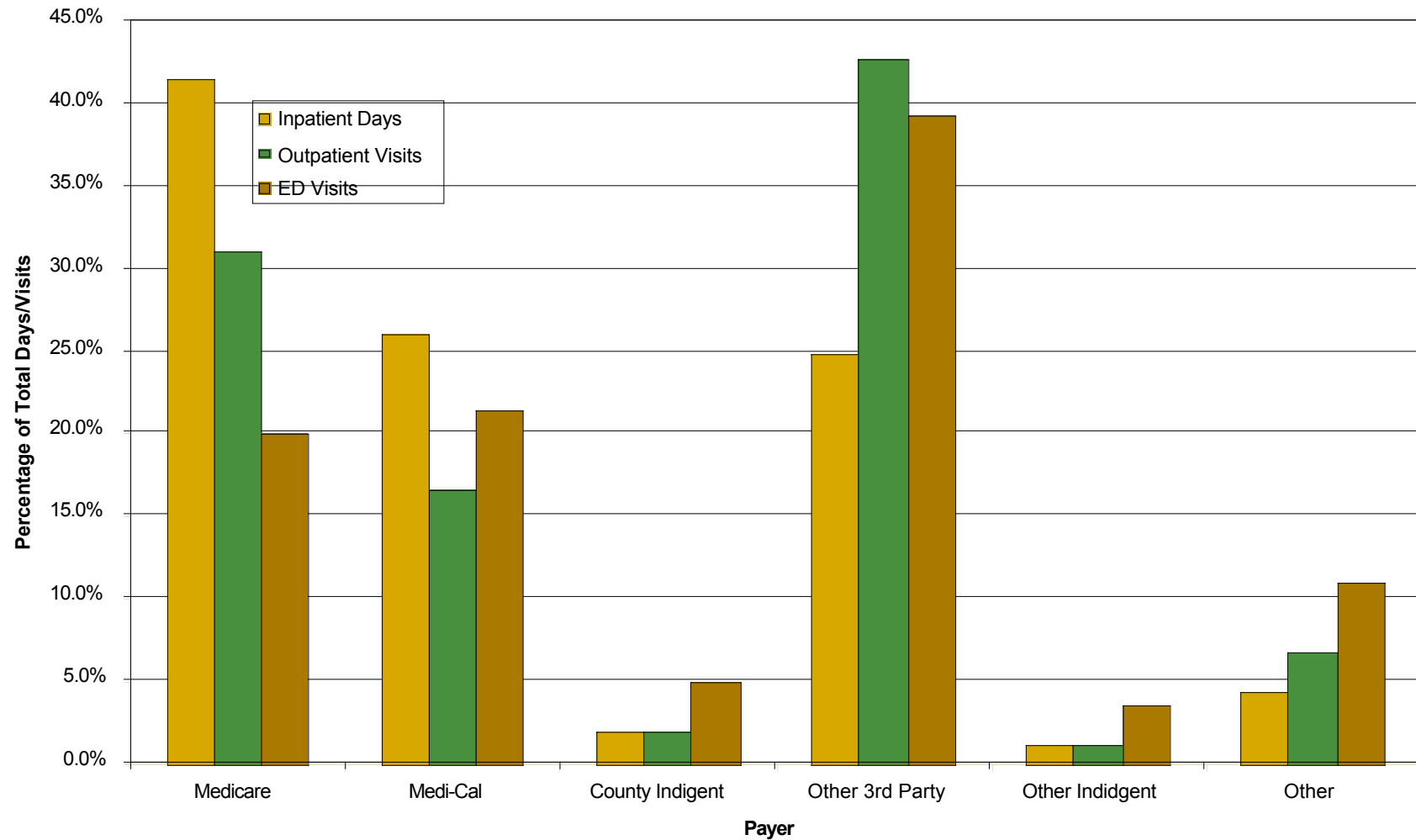

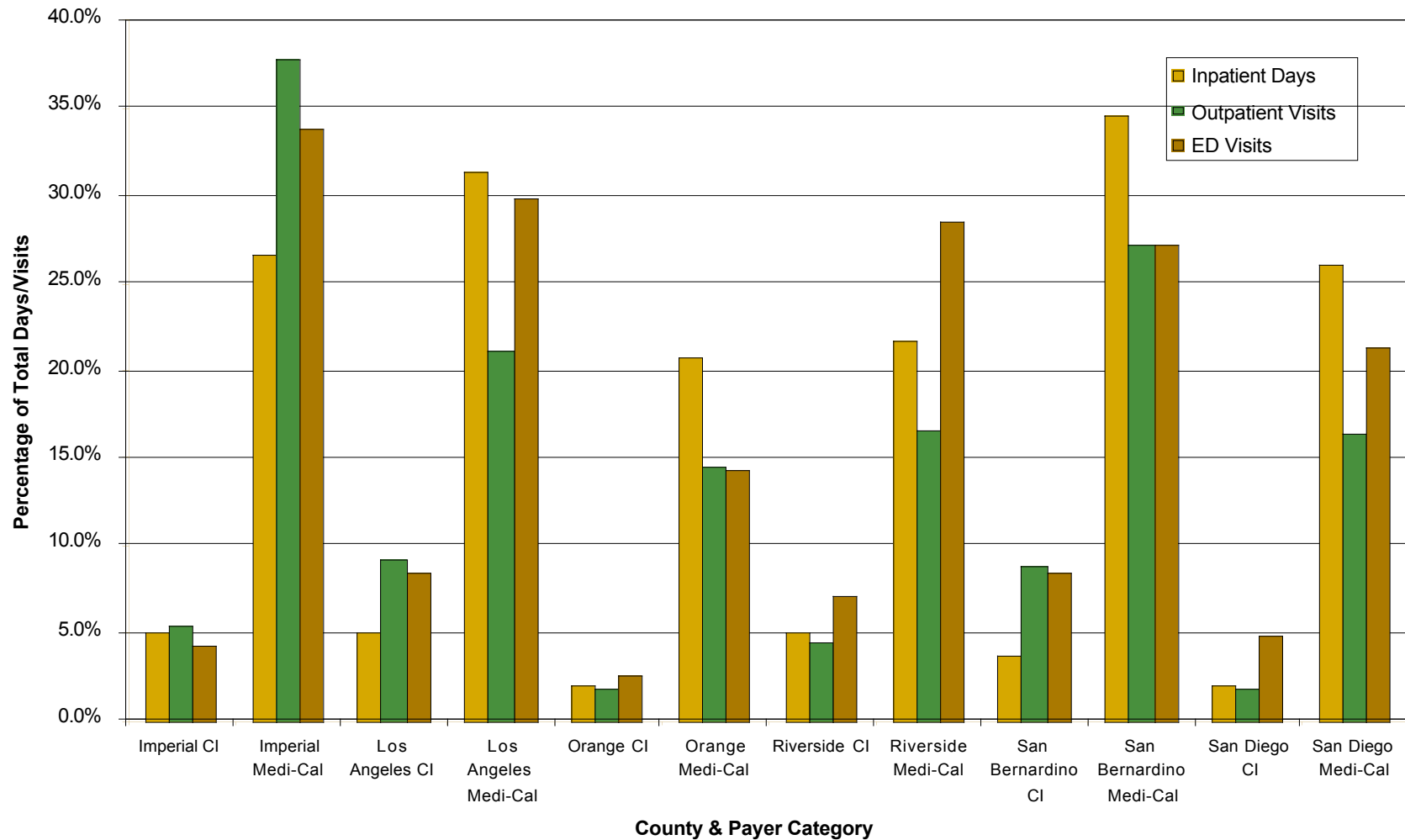

## Hospital Utilization by Payer in San Diego County



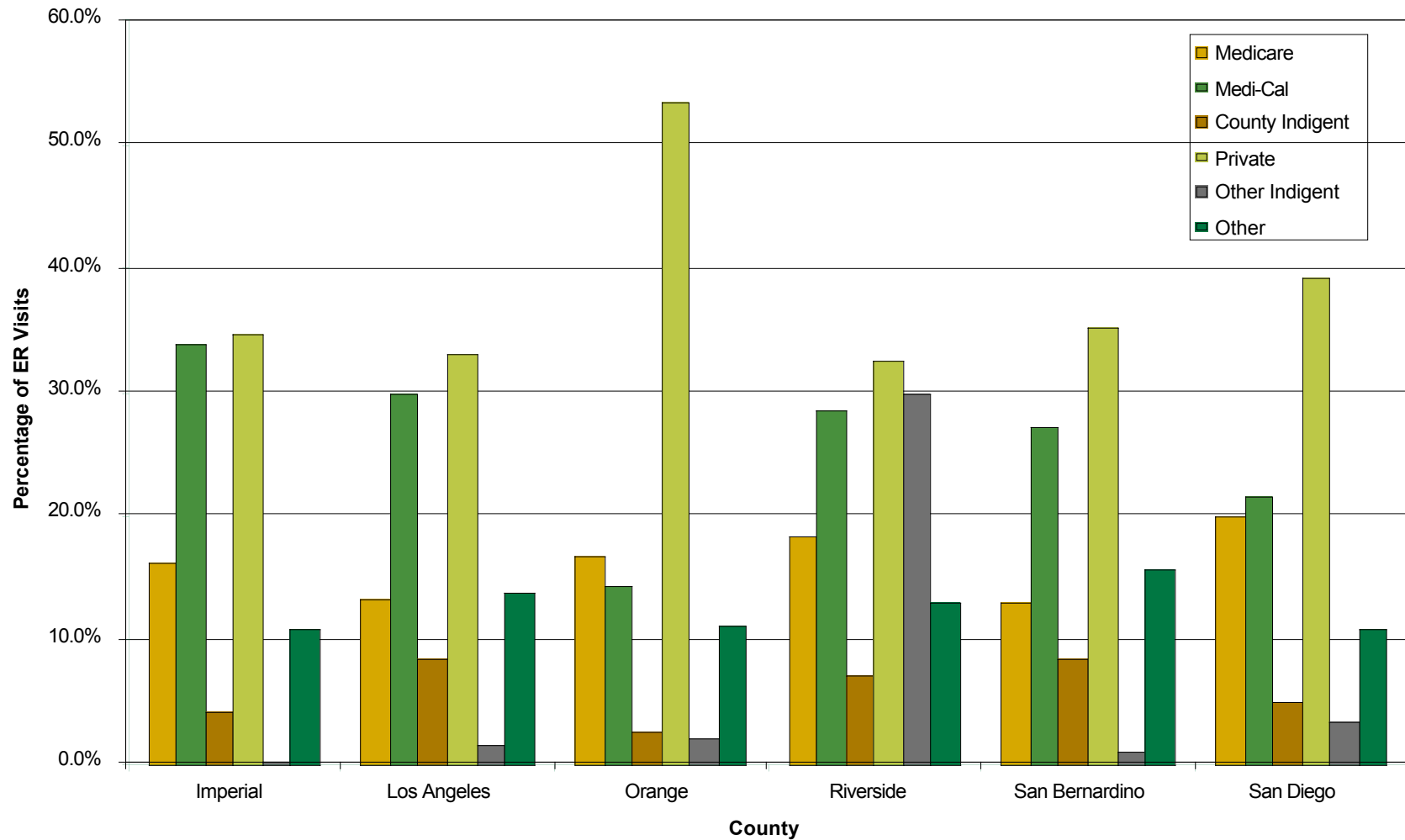

## County Indigent & Medi-Cal Patients' Hospital Utilization



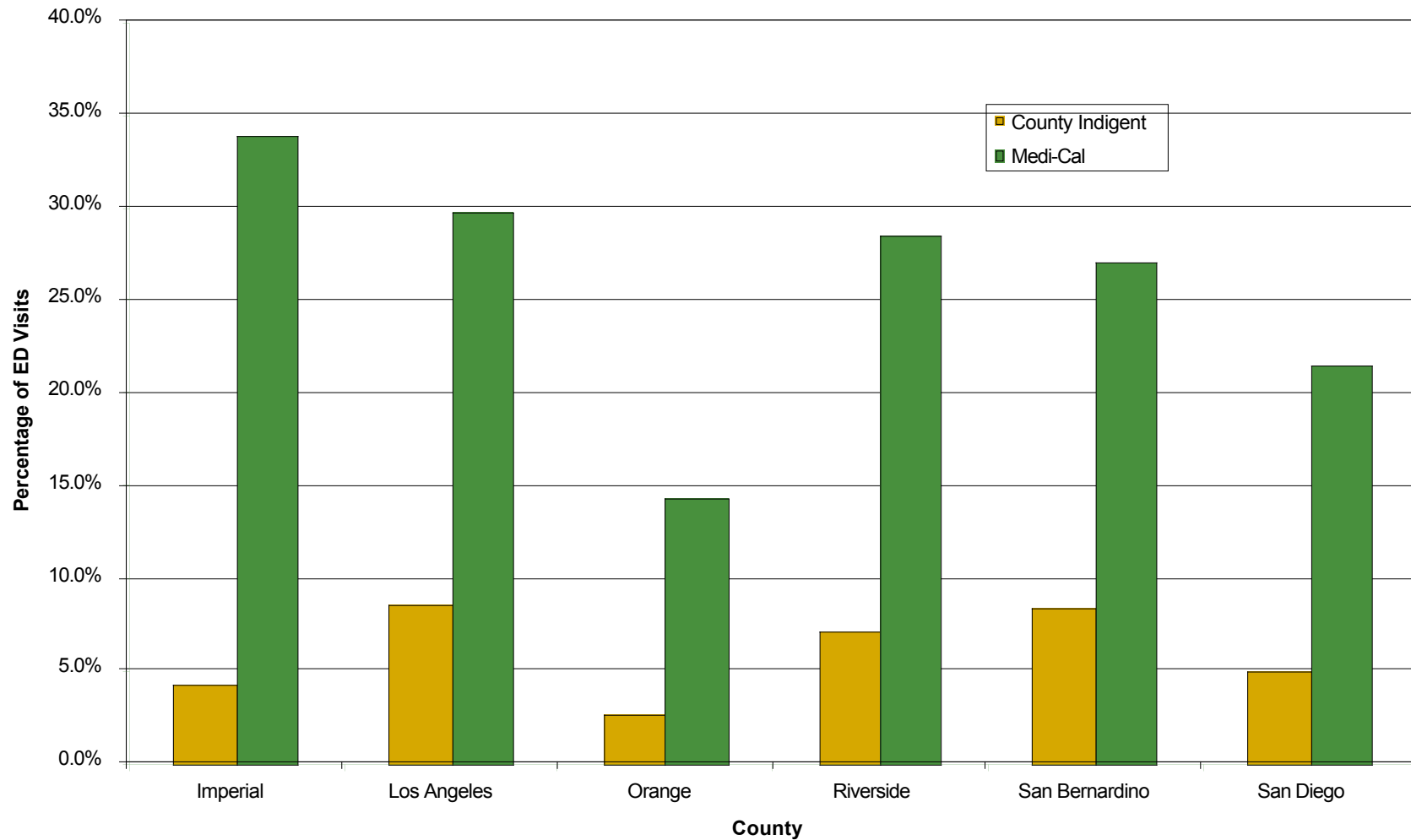

## Emergency Department Utilization by Payer and County



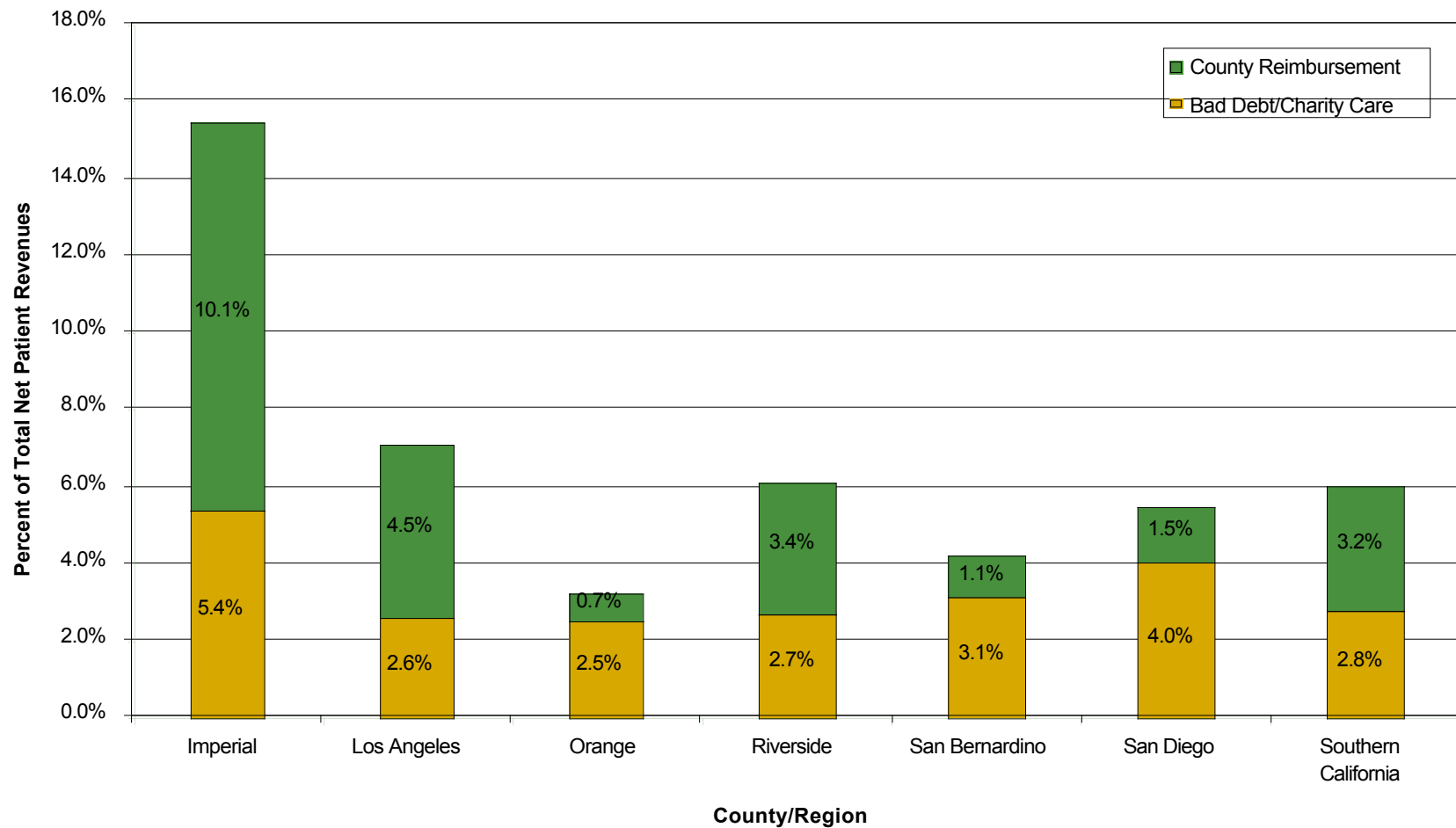

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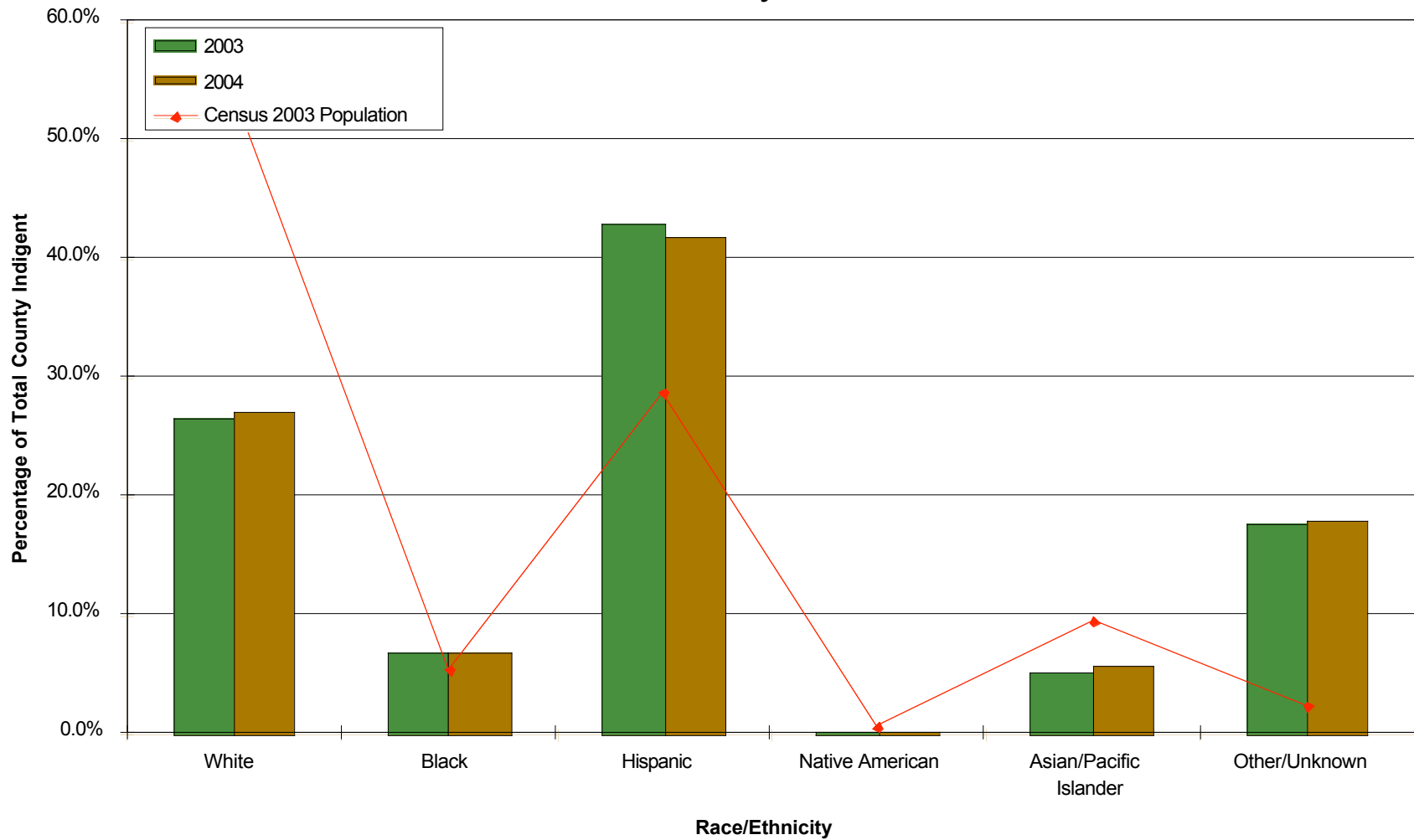

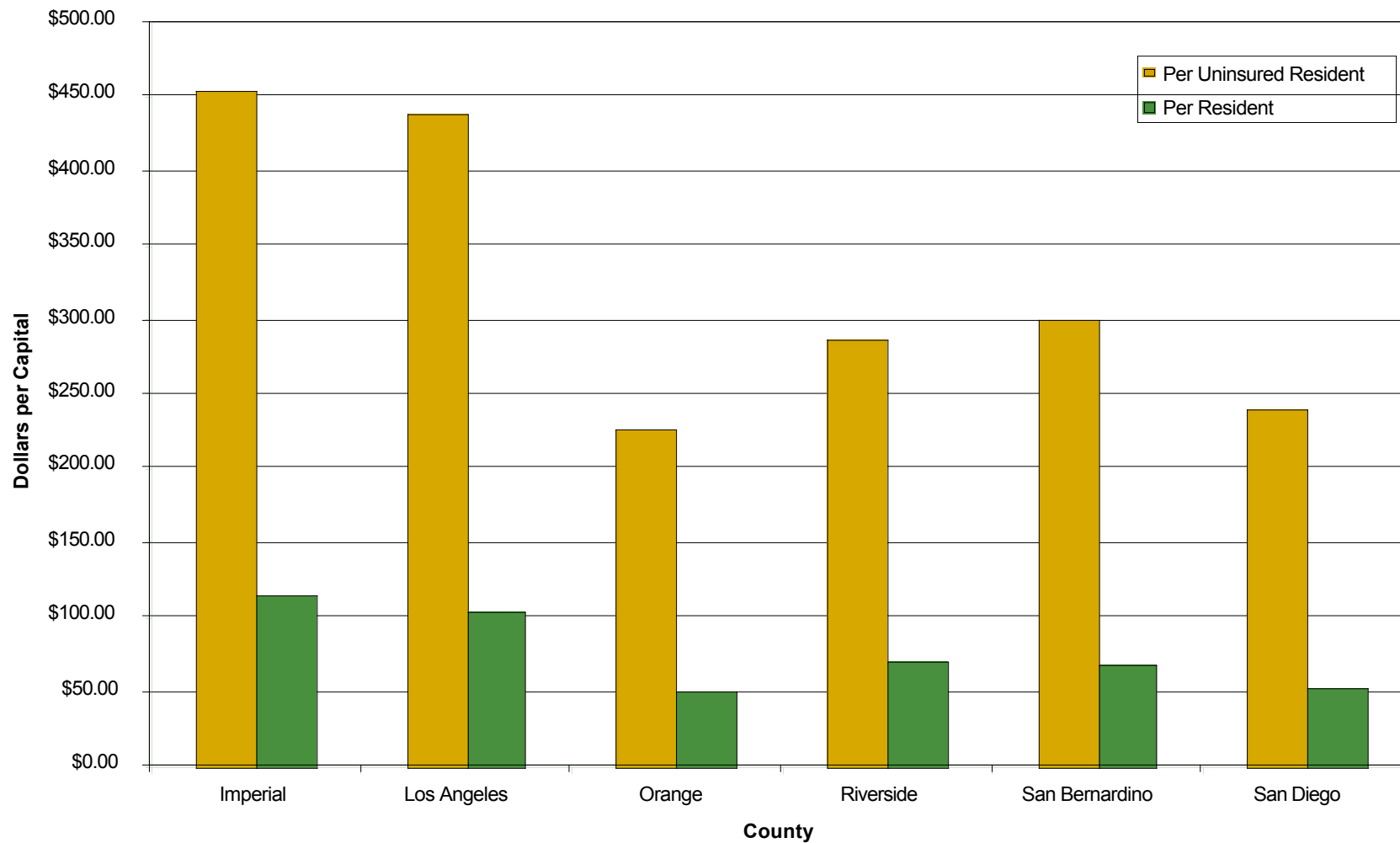

## Race/Ethnicity of County Indigent Patients in San Diego County



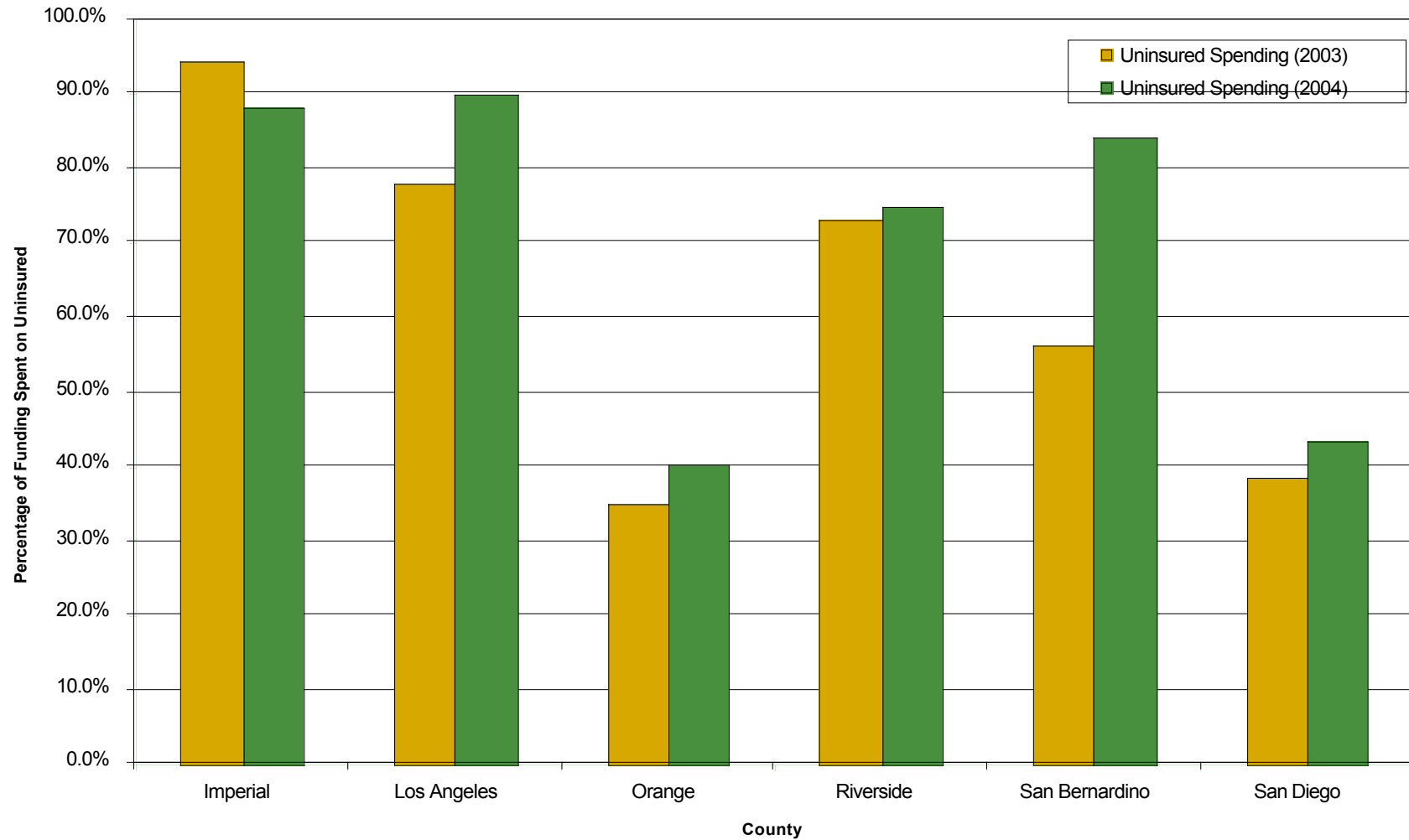

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# Summary

- San Diego County has a slightly lower percentage of its population living below poverty than Southern California regional average as well as lower proportions of its population using county programs. Its Healthy Families percentages, however, are comparable.
- San Diego County's community clinics receive a larger proportion of their funding from patient fees than the regional average.
- San Diego County receives the second lowest amount of funding per uninsured resident among Southern California counties and spends the second lowest percentage of its funding on the uninsured.
