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The LA County Jail System

Big

- Largest in the country – over 16,000 individuals (2x Rikers)
- Short length of stay – 60 days
- 53% are pre-trial

Sick

- Approx. 30% are mentally ill – averaged 5,110 last year
- 66% increase in mental health population since 2013
- An estimated 66% have substance use disorder
- Over 500 in housing for people w complex medical conditions

Vulnerable

- 12% self-identify as homeless
- 55% self-identify as uninsured – 2/3 with insurance had Medi-Cal

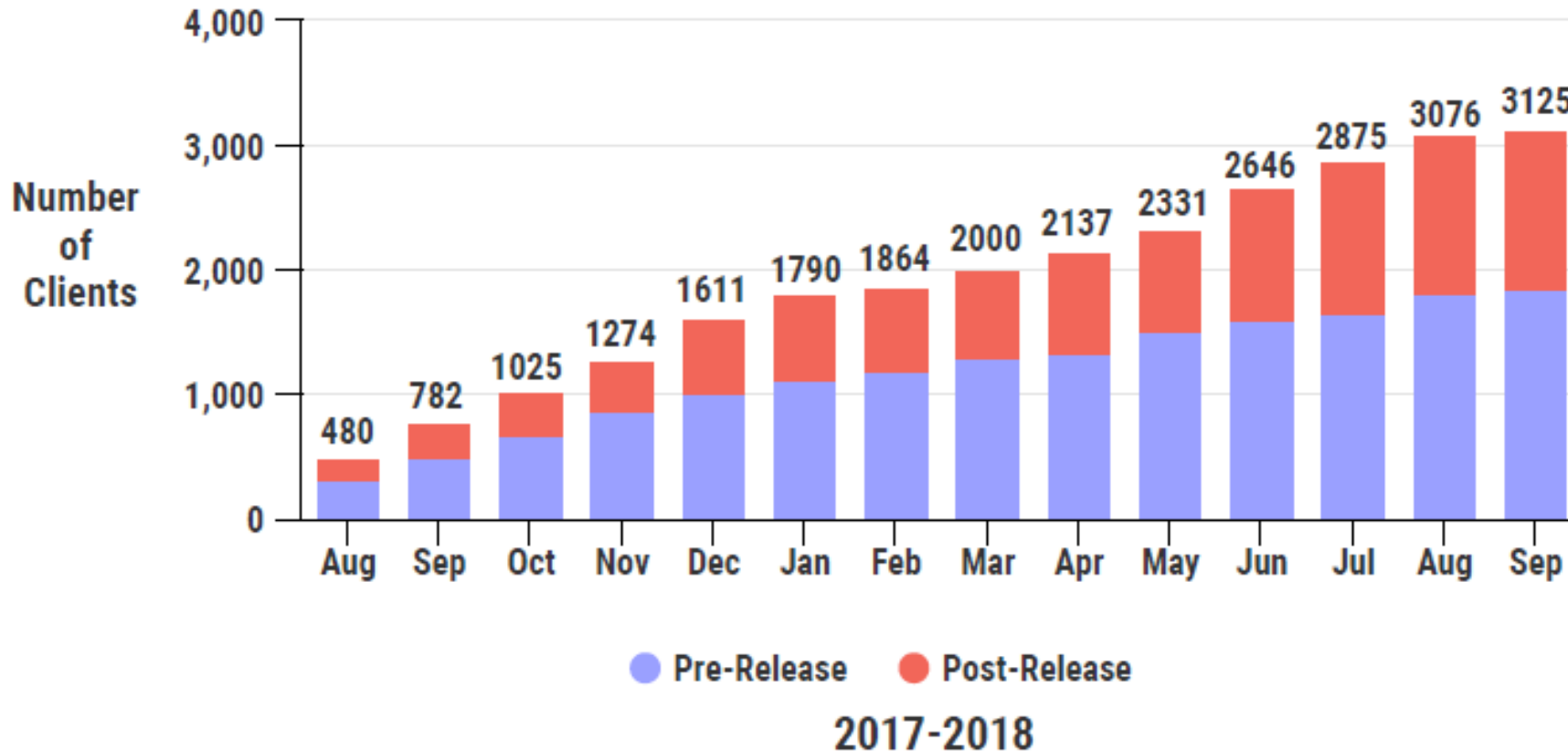


Building Bridges – Jail Health Post ACA

5,760 justice-involved clients served '17- '18

84% of all post-release clients covered by Medi-Cal

62% of clients had at least one chronic condition
