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First Year Highlights

- February 1st 2017: Riverside Live with multiple levels of service
 - Residential LOC: 3.1, 3.3, 3.5, 3.2WM
 - Outpatient: 1.0, 2.1
 - Prevention: IPS, DUI, Universal
- Residential LOC Comparison 15/16 Pre-Waiver to 17/18 Full Waiver Year:
 - 30% Increase Consumers served
 - 84% Increase in days of service received
 - 142% Increase in 3.2WM access
- Budget and Revenue
 - 88% increase in DMC revenue in first 18 months
 - Ability to use SABG for other needs in continuum
 - Expansion of IPS
 - Recovery Residences

Year Two Happenings and Challenges

- Creation of SWAG: Southern Waiver Accountability Group
 - Riverside, Los Angeles, Orange, San Diego, Kern, Imperial, San Bernardino
- Challenges in MAT Expansion
- Operation and Staffing of Access Center
 - 3,500 calls a month
 - Coverage, shifts, and weekend placements
- Integration and Work with FQHC
- Integration and Work with Emergency Departments
- Field Based Outreach Teams and Collaboration with BOS and other County Departments

Current Numbers, Goals and Dreams

- Improvement on 79.6% timeliness from first face to face to admission
- Improvements in transitions (UCLA Report)
 - What about BH and FQHC?
 - Double Checking numbers!
- Operation and Staffing of Access Center
 - 3,500 calls a month
 - Coverage, shifts, and weekend placements
- Provider and County SAPT System: Still Need More!!!
 - Providers: 16 entities with 51 Sites
 - County SAPT Clinics: 15
 - Recovery Residences: 7
 - County SAPT Prevention sites 123
- Quality Implications, tweaking workflows
 - Providers
