FIGURE 2. Employer-Sponsored Coverage, 2019²



FIGURE 3. Percent of Counties' Populations Enrolled in Covered California, December 2020³




FIGURE 4. Covered California Enrollment by Race/Ethnicity, December 2020³




FIGURE 5. Covered California Enrollment by FPL, December 2020³

FIGURE 7. Medi-Cal Enrollment, April 2021^{4,5,6}




FIGURE 8. Medi-Cal Enrollment, by Race/Ethnicity, April 2021^{4,5,6}




FIGURE 9. Medi-Cal Enrollment in Managed Care and Fee-For-Service (FFS), March 20217






FIGURE 10. Medicare Enrollment and Percent of Counties' Population, 20198





FIGURE 11. Medicare Enrollment, by Race/Ethnicity⁹
