


**FIGURE 1. Race/Ethnicity Among the Uninsured, 2021<sup>2</sup>**


**FIGURE 2. Employer-Sponsored Coverage, 2021<sup>2</sup>**






**FIGURE 3.** Percent of County's Population Enrolled in Covered California, December 2022<sup>3</sup>




