



Figure 1. Potential Impact of COVID-19 on Employer-Sponsored Coverage




Figure 3. Covered California Enrollment by FPL, March 2020⁶

Figure 4. Covered California Enrollment by Health Plan, March 2020⁶




Figure 5. Impact of COVID-19 on Covered California Enrollment⁷

Figure 6. Medi-Cal Enrollment by Population and Percent of County, March 20208




Figure 7. Medi-Cal Enrollment by County, June 2020


