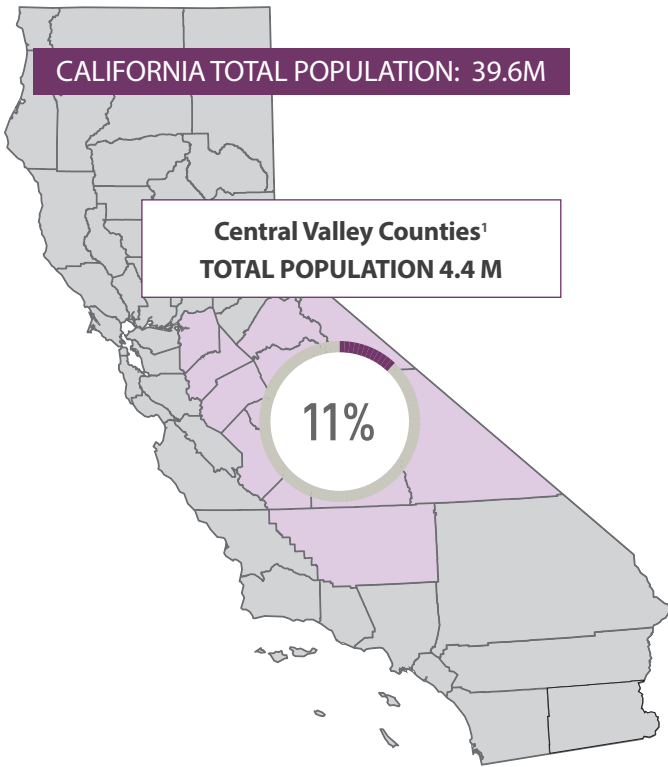

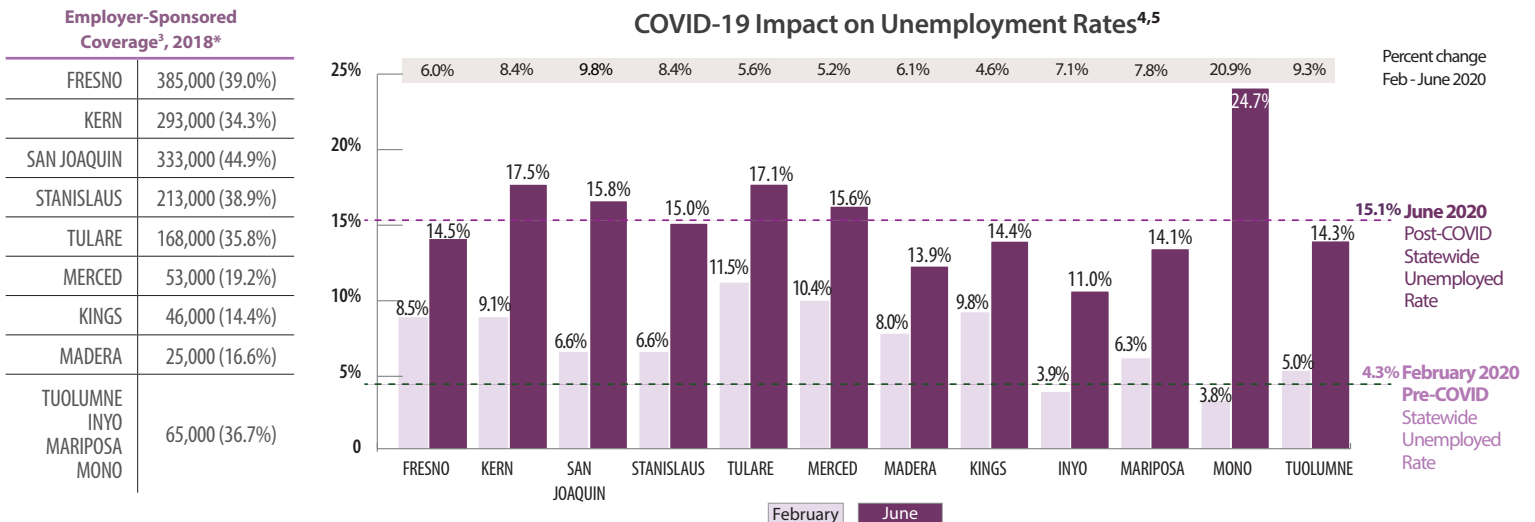

Figure 2. Covered California Enrollment by County, March 2020⁶

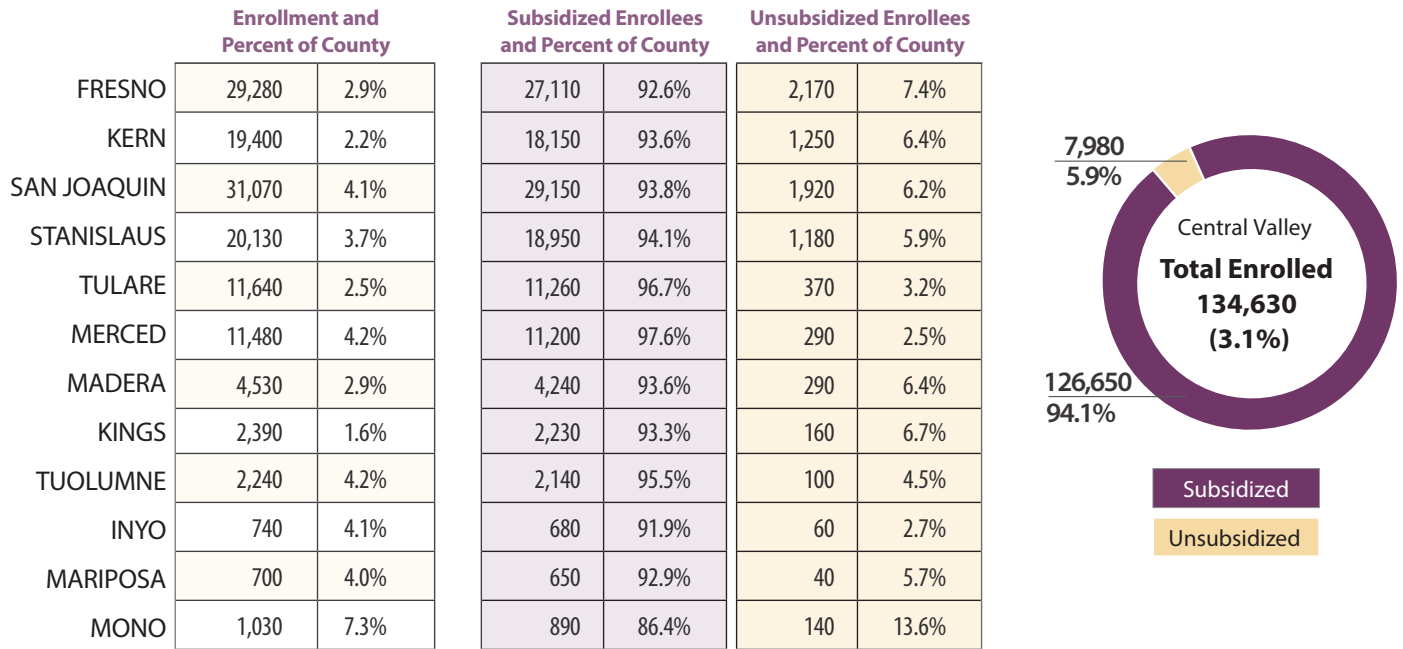


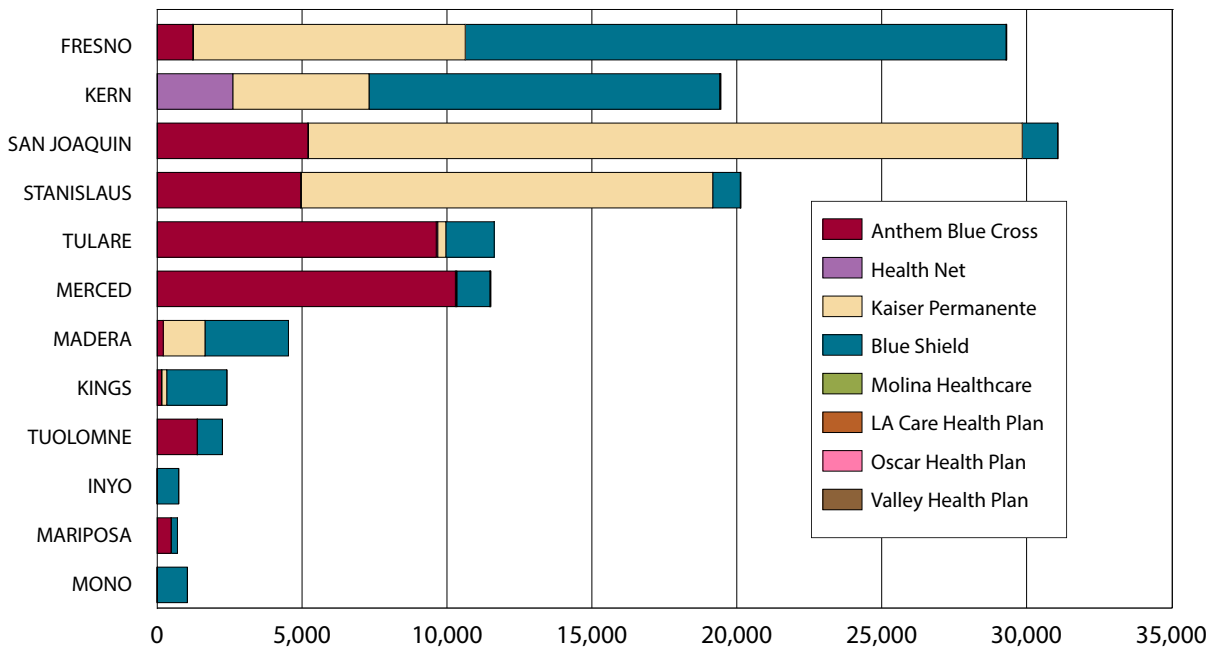
Figure 3. Covered California Enrollment by FPL, March 2020⁵

Figure 6. Medi-Cal Enrollment by Population and Percent of County, March 2020⁸

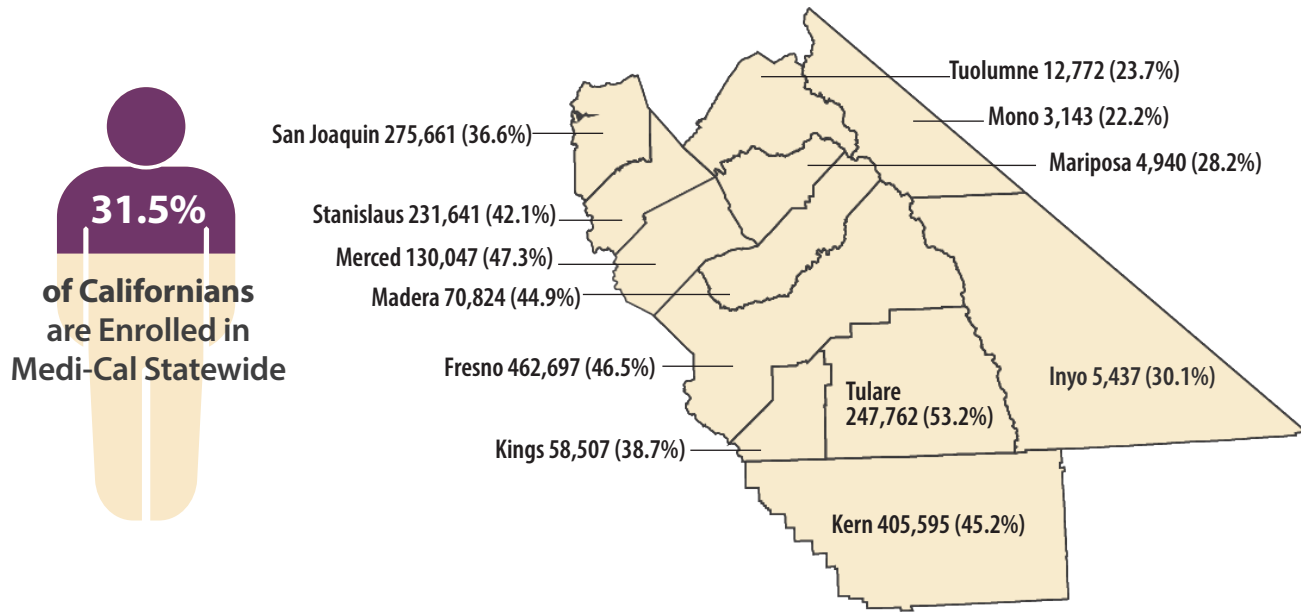


Figure 7. Medi-Cal Enrollment, by County, March 2020
