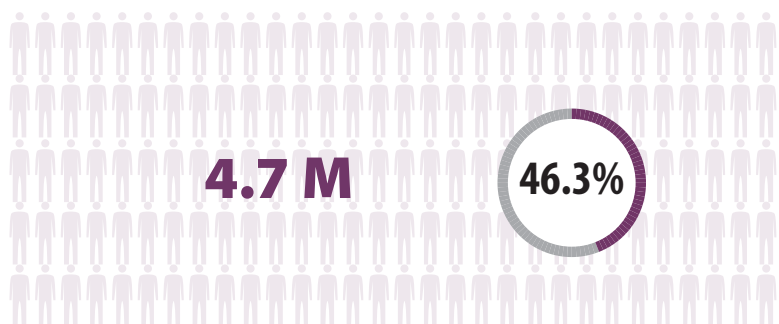
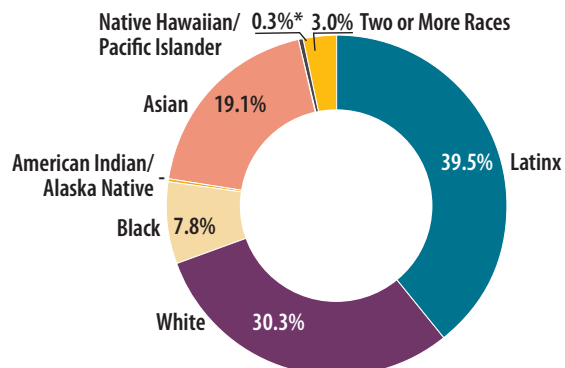


Figure 4: Race/Ethnicity Breakdown Among Californians with Employer-Sponsored Coverage, 2019²

Figure 5: County's Population Enrolled in Covered California, December 2020^{1,3}

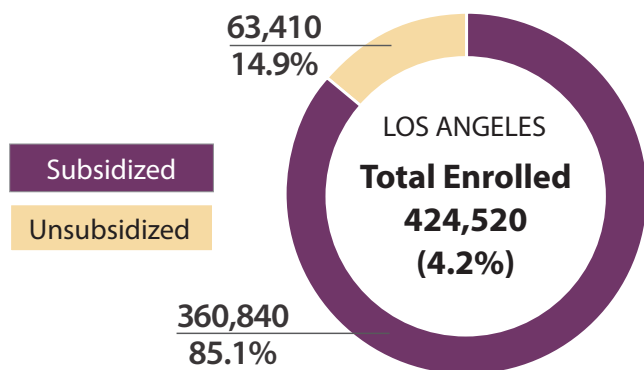

Figure 6: Covered California Enrollment by Race/Ethnicity, December 2020³

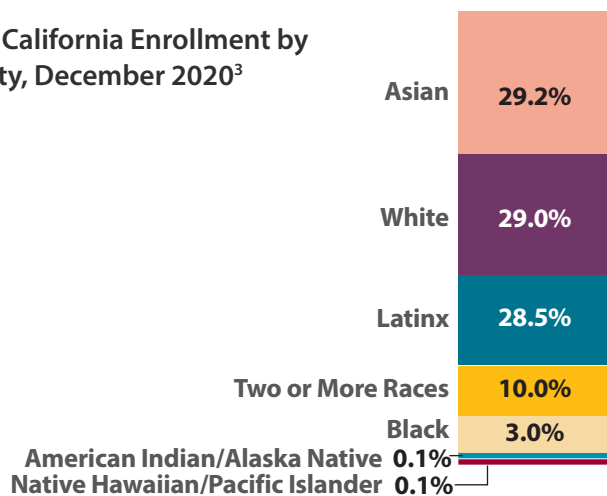
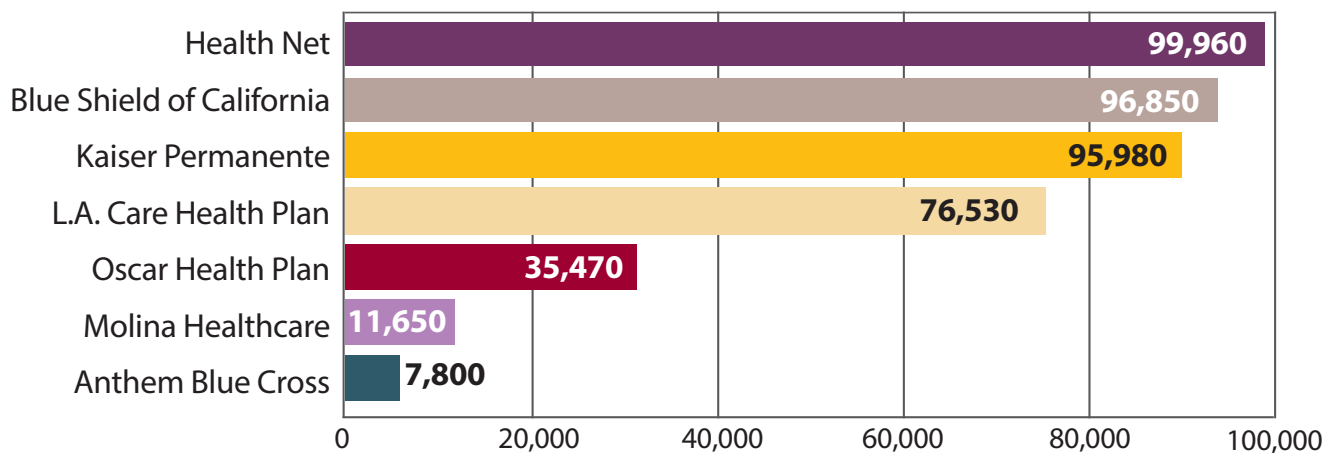


Figure 7: Covered California Enrollment by Health Plan, December 2020³

Figure 8: Medi-Cal Enrollment and Percent of County's Population, February 2021^{4,5,6}

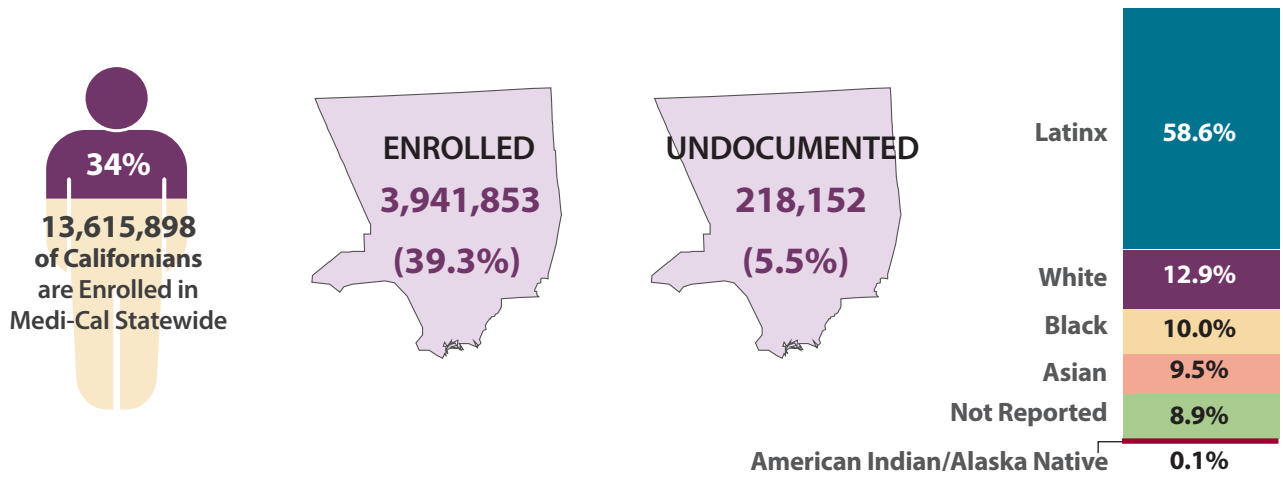
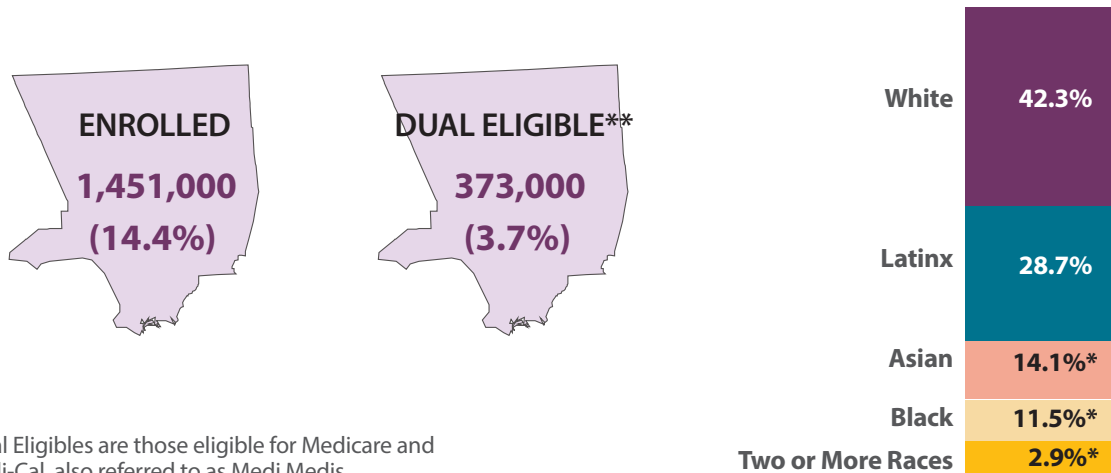
