Figure 1: Total Uninsured in Orange County, 2019²




Figure 2: Uninsured in Orange County with Incomes ≤ 138% Federal Poverty Level (FPL), 2019²

Figure 5: Orange County's Population Enrolled in Covered California, December 2020^{1,3}



Figure 6: Covered California Enrollment in Orange County by Race/Ethnicity, December 2020³






Figure 7: Covered California Enrollment in Orange County by Health Plan, December 2020³



Covered California's privacy policy rounds all figures to the nearest 10, as a result, grand totals shown may be slightly different from the totals in the individual plan data.


