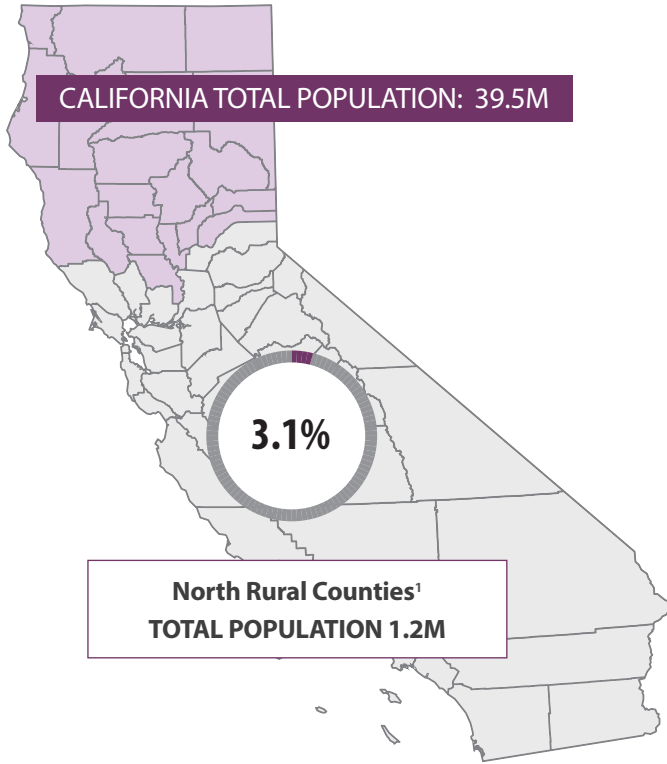

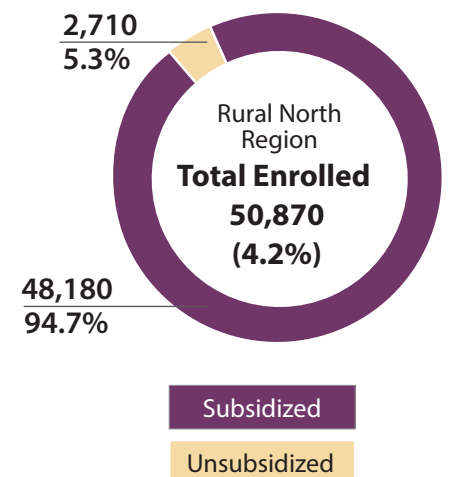

FIGURE 3. Percent of Counties' Populations Enrolled in Covered California, March 2021⁴

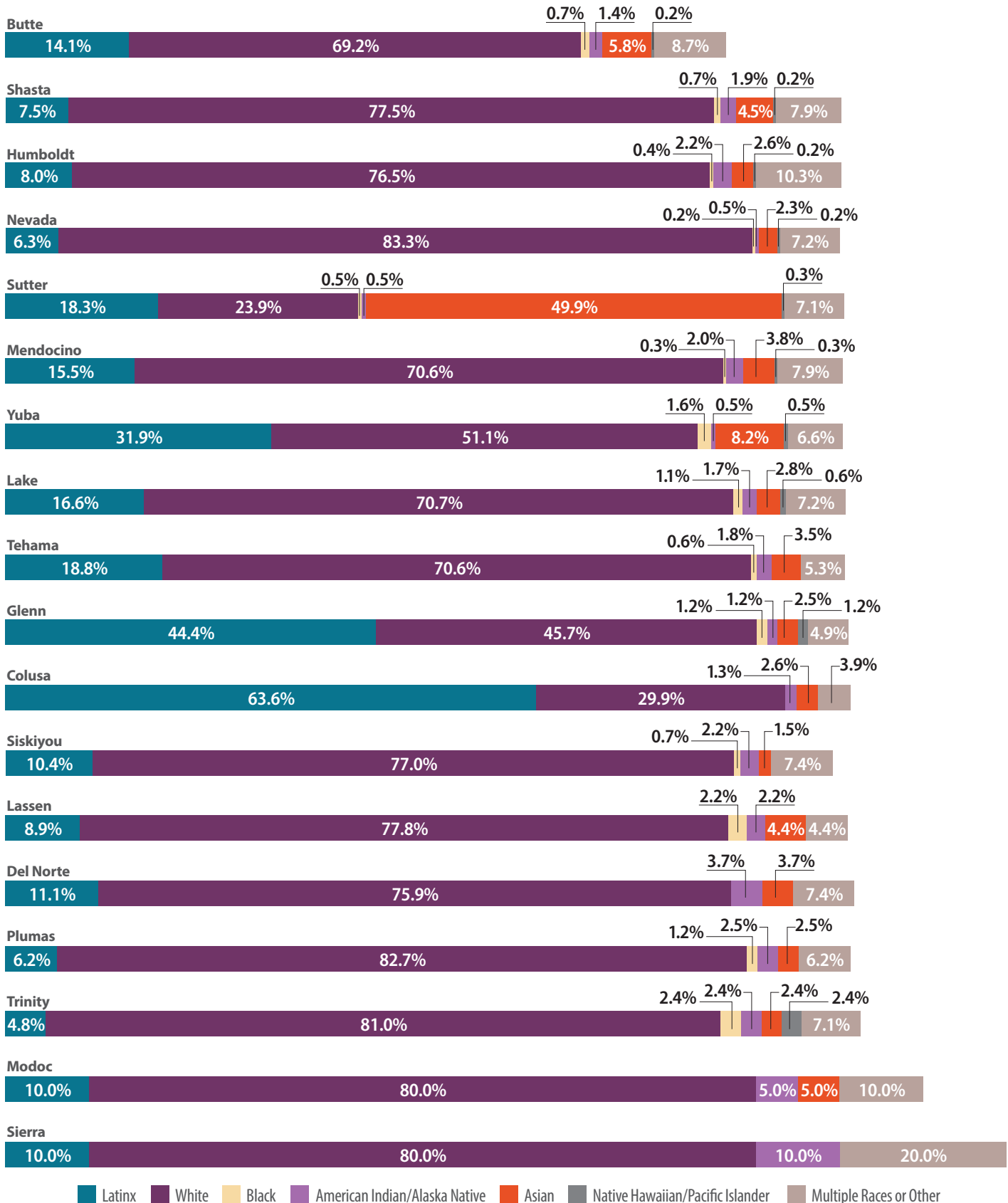

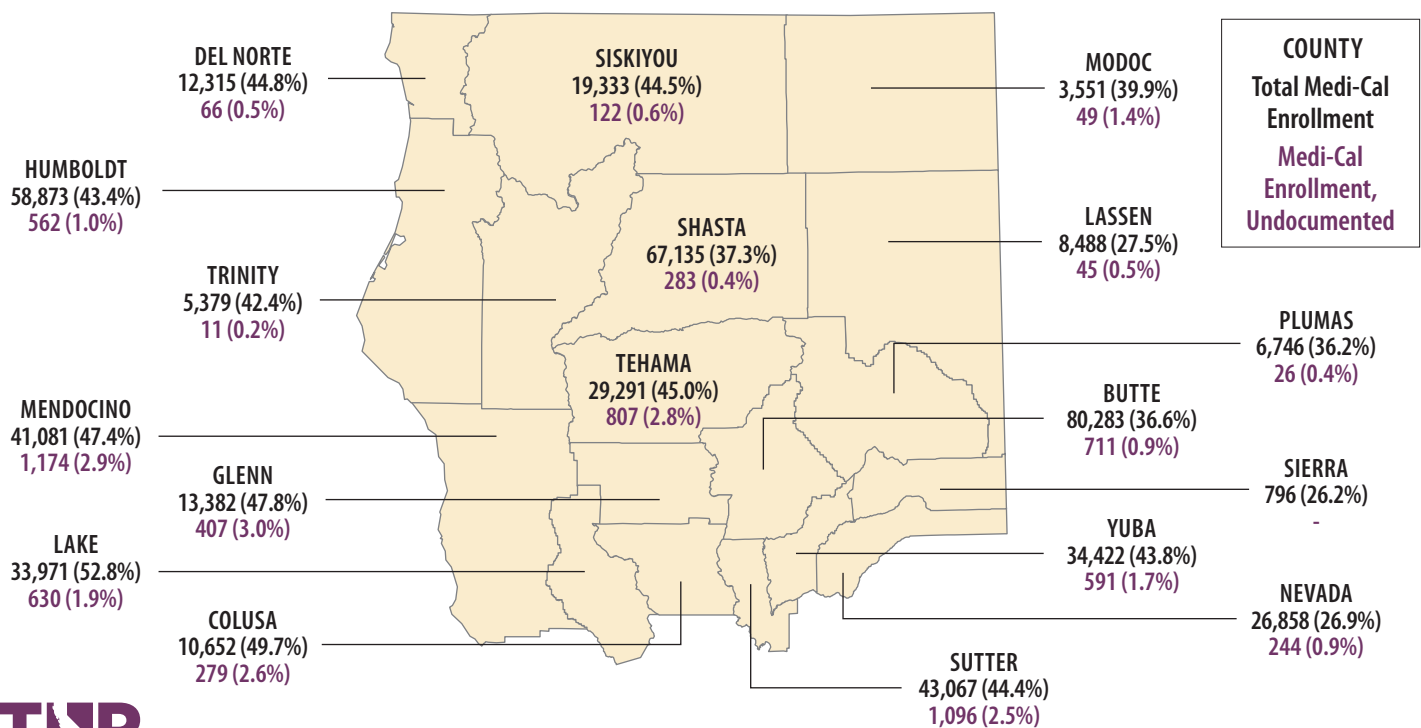
FIGURE 6. Covered California by Health Plan, March 2021⁴

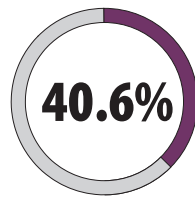
FIGURE 7. Medi-Cal Enrollment, June 2021^{5,6}

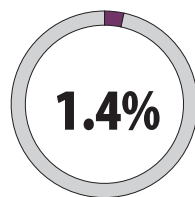


FIGURE 8. Medi-Cal Enrollment, by Race/Ethnicity, June 2021⁷
