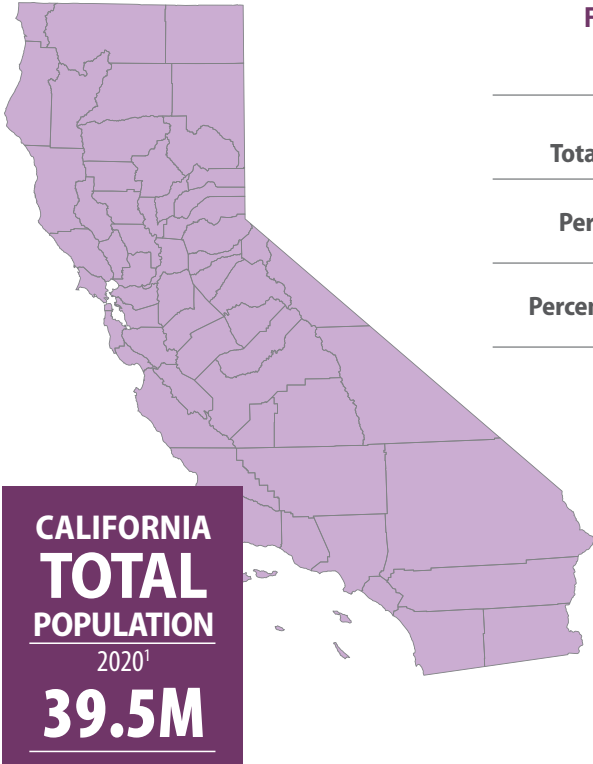

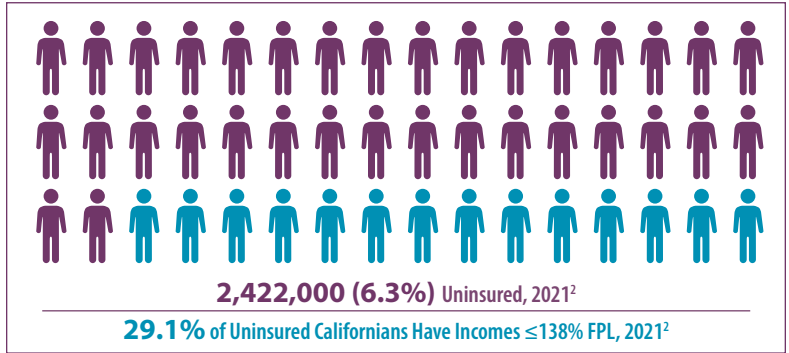

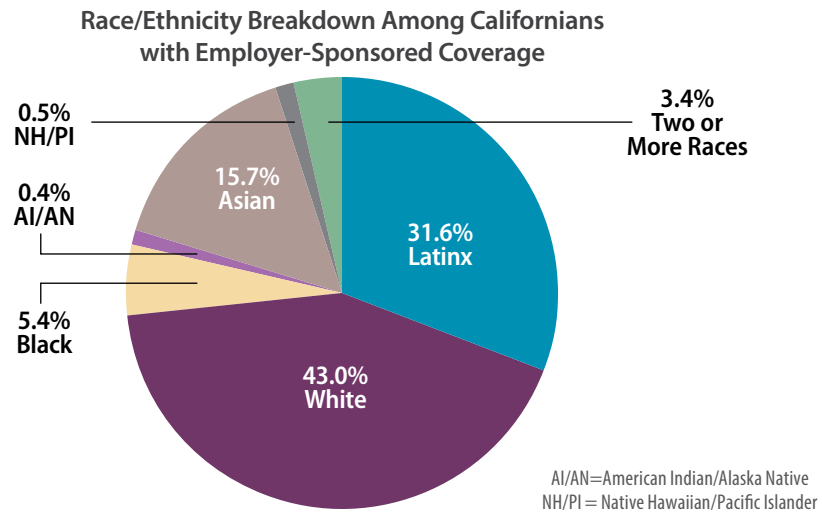
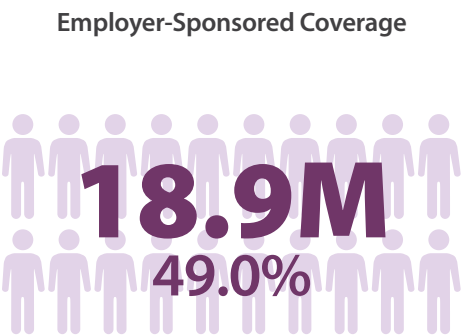
**FIGURE 1. Race/Ethnicity and Insurance Status Across California<sup>2</sup>**

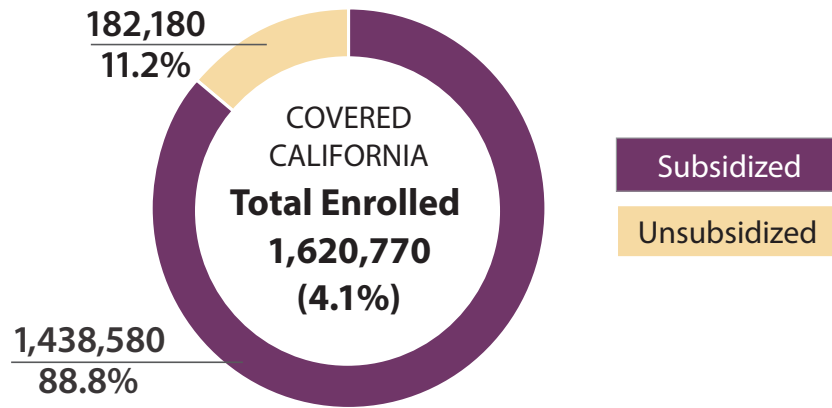
**FIGURE 2. Employer-Sponsored Coverage, 2021<sup>2</sup>**



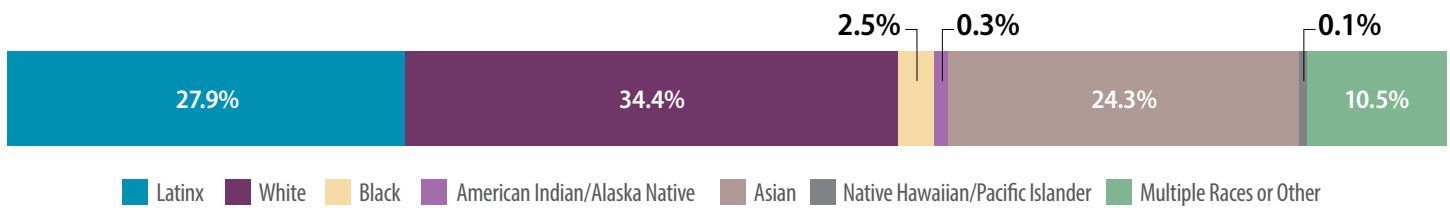

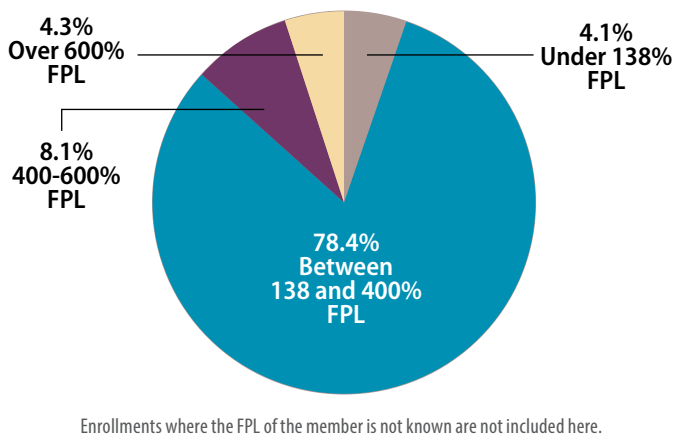
**FIGURE 3.** Percent of California Population Enrolled in Covered California, December 2022<sup>3</sup>

FIGURE 7. Medi-Cal Enrollment, April 2023<sup>4,5</sup>

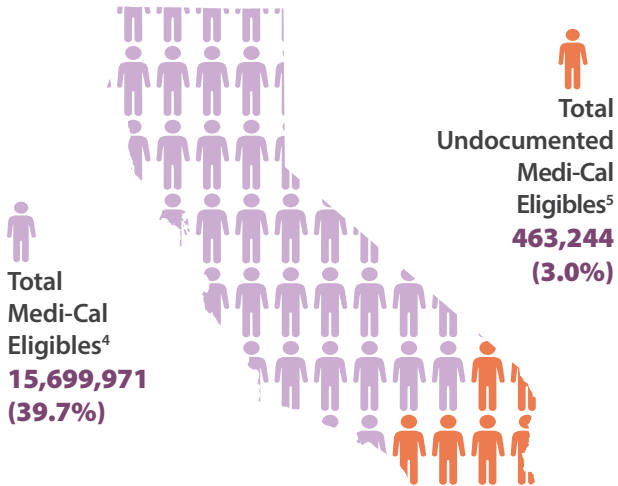


FIGURE 8. Medi-Cal Enrollment, by Race/Ethnicity, May 2023<sup>6</sup>

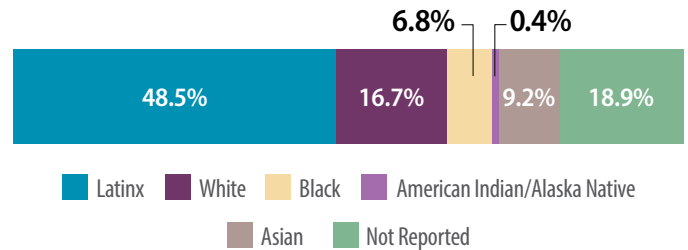
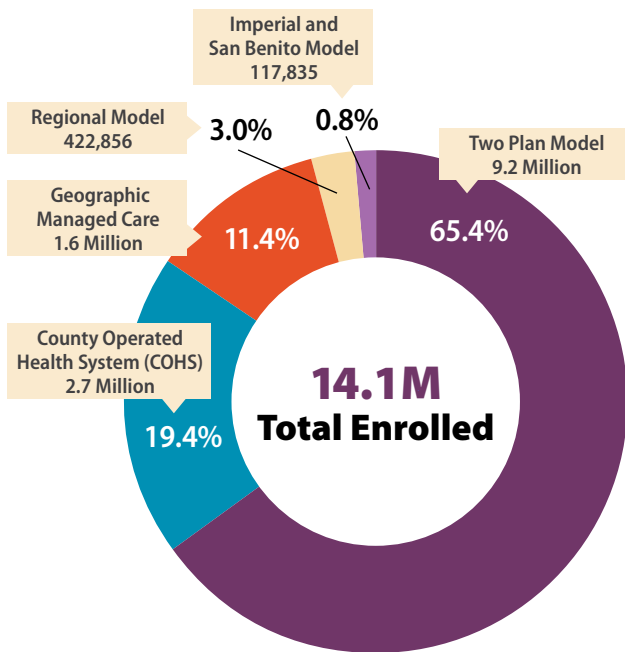


FIGURE 9. Upcoming Changes to Managed Care Plan (MCP) Models

In 2024, Kaiser Permanente will be an Option for some Medi-Cal Members in **32** Counties<sup>9</sup>

Newly procured MCP contracts will go into effect January 1, 2024. The new contracts are intended to facilitate coordinated access to care, more culturally competent care, reinvestment in community, and increased transparency to advance health equity, quality, access, accountability, and action.<sup>10</sup> In addition to the new MCP contracts, 14 counties will also take on new MCP models. These counties include Alameda, Alpine, Contra Costa, Colusa, El Dorado, Glenn, Mariposa, Nevada, Placer, Plumas, Sierra, Sutter, Tehama, and Yuba.<sup>11</sup>



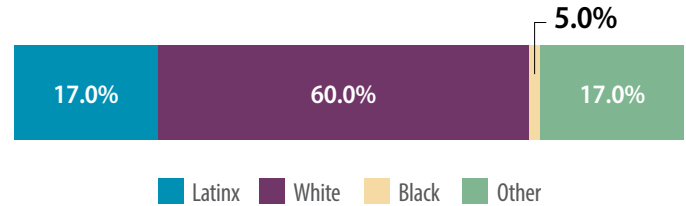
